## Light Vote Predicted In Oregon Primary Election

SALEM (AP) — Fewer than half of Oregon's 785,285 registered voters are expected to vote in Friday's primary election, which has the distinction of offering the smallest number of statewide or congressional contests in many years.

Interest has been centered chiefly on the Republican contest for governor and upon Multnomah County's congressional race, but many lively local and legislative battles are being depended upon to bring out the voters.

The campaign for governor, in the doldrums until last week when Secretary of State Earl T. Newberry came out for federal power development, finds Gov. Paul L. Patterson seeking election in his own right. He became governor 17 months ago when, as Senate president, he succeeded Douglas McKay when McKay became secretary of the interior.

The winner in this Patterson-Newberry contest will face Joseph K. Carson Jr. in the fall. Carson, former mayor of Portland who has served on the U. S. Maritime Commission, has no opposition for the Democratic nomination.

In the Republican race for Congress in Multnomah County, Rep. Homer D. Angell, dean of Oregon's congressional delegation who has served since 1939, is facing his hardest battle. His principal opponent is Tom Lawson McCall, radio commentator who was secretary of former Gov. McKay. The third man in the contest is A. W. Laferty, who was in Congress from 1911 to 1915.

Mrs. Edith Green, Portland school and civic leader, is heavily favored to win the Democratic nomination for Angell's seat. She was an unknown two years ago when she gave Newberry a hard battle when Newberry was elected secretary of state.

There aren't any primary contests for the positions held by U. S. Sen. Guy Cordon and the state's three other congressmen.

State Sen. S. Eugene Allen, Portland, is a heavy favorite to win the Republican nomination for labor commissioner. He is running against Herbert E. Barker, Salem labor leader, who isn't nearly as well known as Allen. This is the only other statewide contest on the ballot.

Nominations will be made for 16 State Senate seats, with contests for half of them.

The most interesting of these is the race in Umatilla County, where Sen. Rex Ellis, Pendleton veteran whose district was abolished by reapportionment, is running for the Republican seat held by Sen. W. Lowell Steen, Milton-Freewater farmer. Steen was a newcomer at the 1959 session.

Nine senators — seven Republicans and two Democrats — are seeking reelection to the Senate. In the races for the 60 positions in the State House of Representatives, 30 Republicans and nine Democrats seek reelection.

The most dramatic of these contests also involves reapportionment. Rep. David C. Baum, La Grande, candidate for speaker of the House who failed in his long court battle against the reapportionment amendment, lost his district, too. So he is running against Rep. H. R. Weatherford, Walla Walla, for Republican nomination.

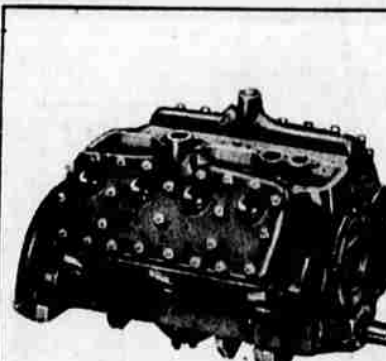

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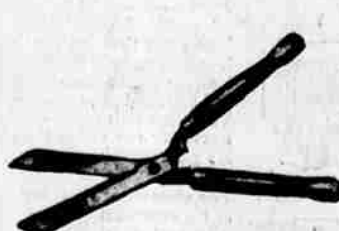
