GLAMOUR SOUP is simple to prepare and many a smart hostess takes simple ingredients and concocts a taste that becomes a specialty at her table. Vichyssoise is certainly in the glamour class, probably because of its association with fine restaurants rather than its intricacy of preparation. This adaptation comes from the National Dairy Council and is ideal for a summer lunch or introductory course for a fine dinner. It is quickly made and should be stored in the refrigerator for use without further cooking.

VICHYSOISE AT HOME

- 5 leeks or 1 1/2 cups sliced mild onions
- 4 tablespoons butter
- 3 cups thinly sliced potatoes
- 1 cup hot water
- 4 chicken bouillon cubes
- 3 cups hot milk
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon paprika
- 1 cup cream
- 2 tablespoons chopped chives or parsley

Cut roots and tops from leeks, leaving 2 inches above the white part; cut in thin slices (same procedure if using large green onions). Melt butter in a saucepan; add leeks and cook slowly until tender but not brown. Add sliced potatoes, hot water and 1 chicken bouillon cube. Cover and cook over medium heat until potatoes are tender. Press leeks, potatoes and liquid through a sieve. Dissolve three remaining bouillon cubes in hot milk. Combine with puree and seasonings. Add cream. Chill thoroughly. Garnish with chopped

Strawberry Pudding Pie

Don't let the strawberry season slip by without trying this quick- trick dessert. The crust is made of ladyfingers. The filling is a packaged pudding, flavor-enriched with sherry, spread over a layer of sugared strawberries. It comes from Emily Chase Leistner, foods consultant, California Wine Insti- tute.

STRAWBERRY PIE

- 1 package vanilla pudding powder
- 1 1/2 cups milk
- 1/4 cup California sherry wine
- 1 doz. ladyfingers, split
- 2 cups halved or sliced straw- berries
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 cup heavy cream, whipped
- additional whole strawberries for garnish

Prepare vanilla pudding accord- ing to directions on package, using the 1 1/2 cups milk as the liquid. Re- move from heat. Stir in wine. Let cool at room temperature, stirring two or three times. Line the bottom and sides of a 9-inch pie plate with split ladyfingers, arranging them split side up. Mix the halved or sliced strawberries with the sugar; spread berries evenly over the ladyfinger "crust" on the bottom of the pan. Spread cooled pudding evenly over berries. Chill pie sev- eral hours. Just before serving, spread whipped cream over the top and garnish with whole straw- berries. Makes one 9-inch pie.

DO IT YOURSELF WITH PREMIX

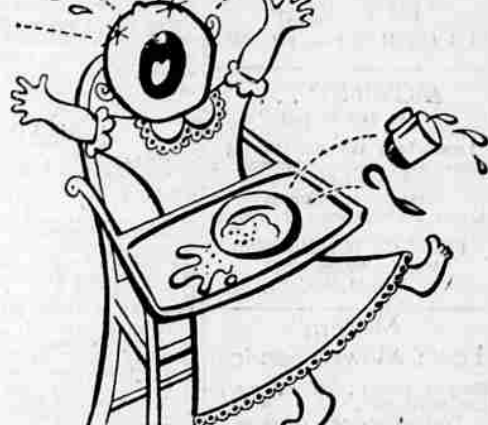
