**NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE**

Oral auction bids will be received by the Regional Forester or his authorized representative at the office of the Forest Supervisor, Federal Court Room, Post Office Building, Medford, Oregon, beginning at 2:00 p.m., Pacific Standard Time, June 21, 1954, for all the live timber marked or designated for cutting and all merchantable dead timber located on an area embracing about 2,422 acres within Section 31a, 32, and 33, T. 53 S., R. 6 E., and Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, T. 34 S., R. 6 E., W.M., in the Three Mile Creek Drainage, Rogue River National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be 21,500,000 board feet, more or less, of ponderosa pine; 800,000 board feet, more or less, of sugar pine; 100,000 board feet, more or less, of white pine; 1,500,000 board feet, more or less, of Douglas-fir; and 16,200,000 board feet, more or less, of white fir and other species of saw-timber. The appraised value of the timber according to long-term, normal market and operating conditions is \$21.00 per M board feet for ponderosa pine; \$21.00 per M board feet for sugar pine; \$21.00 per M board feet for white pine; \$3.25 per M board feet for Douglas-fir; and \$1.60 per M board feet for white fir and other species. No bid will be considered which is less than these rates as a base rate applicable through the entire period of the sale agreement, plus an additional amount of at least \$0.25 per M board feet for ponderosa pine; \$0.50 per M board feet for sugar pine; \$0.20 per M board feet for white pine; \$1.25 per M board feet for Douglas-fir; and \$0.80 per M board feet for white fir and other species, which additional amounts for all species shall be subject to quarterly calendar adjustment upward or downward by 0.5 of the difference between the base index prices determined as set forth below and the average of the Western Pine Association index prices as calculated by the Forest Service at the end of each quarter. Such adjustment in the additional amounts for stumpage shall be applicable to timber cut and sealed during the calendar quarter for which the adjustment is computed. In no event, however, will the adjusted stumpage rates for each quarter be less than the basic appraised rate as first stated above. The base index prices for this sale are an average of the monthly Western Pine Association lumber prices indices from January 1, 1954, to March 31, 1954. \$1.85 per M board feet, to be used by the Forest Service for paying the cost of slash disposal, and a cooperative deposit of \$0.40 per M board feet, to cover the cost of tree planting, seed sowing and timber stand improvement work on the area cut over, for the total cut of timber under the terms of the agreement, will be required. As a qualification for oral bidding, all bidders must submit a sealed bid accompanied by the required payment to the Forest Supervisor, Post Office Building, Medford, Oregon, prior to 2:00 p.m., Pacific Standard Time, June 21, 1954. Sealed bids will be posted at the beginning of the auction for the information of all bidders. \$20,000.00 must accompany each bid, to be applied on the purchase price, returned, or retained in part as liquidated damages, according to the conditions of sale. If an oral bid is declared to be high at the closing of the auction, the bidder must immediately confirm the oral bid by submitting it in writing on a Forest Service bid form. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved.
