Want Ad Secured First Students For Columbia U.I.
Soon after Columbia University (then known as King's College) was founded 200 years ago Dr. Samuel Johnson, the first president, placed a Want Ad in the New-York-Gazette, or Weekly Post-Boy, to announce a course of tuition in the new school house, adjoining Trinity Church. His ad brought eight enrollees, Columbia's first students.
