The bride's gown, veil or bouquet is no more important than her invisible accessory — her perfume. As she walks down the aisle, part of her loveliness will be the aura of scent that lingers behind. Years later, this fragrance will always evoke in the memory of the wedding guests this picture of the bride because association of experience is one of the mystical powers of perfume.

Whether she is a June bride or an August or October bride, her perfume should have a light, lifting quality. And the bride must take as much care in using her fragrance as in donning her gown and adjusting her veil.

A last minute scenting might prove a discordant note for the most memorable day in her life. The nervous hand is not a safe

one with the perfume bottle. The bride's perfume should be chosen with the same deliberate care she gives her trousseau. EAT BREAKFAST

CORN FLAKES CRUNCH

Place 1/2 lb. caramels and 2 tablespoons water in the top of a double boiler. Cook over boiling water, stirring frequently until caramels are melted. Stir in 1/2 cup salted peanuts. Measure 7 cups Corn Flakes into a large bowl; pour on caramel syrup, mixing until well-coated. Spread lightly in a large shallow pan, separating into bite size pieces. Let stand until firm. Serve as a confection or as a topping for ice cream or puddings.

WHITE MEAT FILLING

Try chicken and almond sandwich filling by combining one cup of coarsely ground white meat of chicken with 1/2 cup ground blanched almonds, 1 tablespoon crushed pineapple and just enough mayonnaise to bind the ingredients.

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
