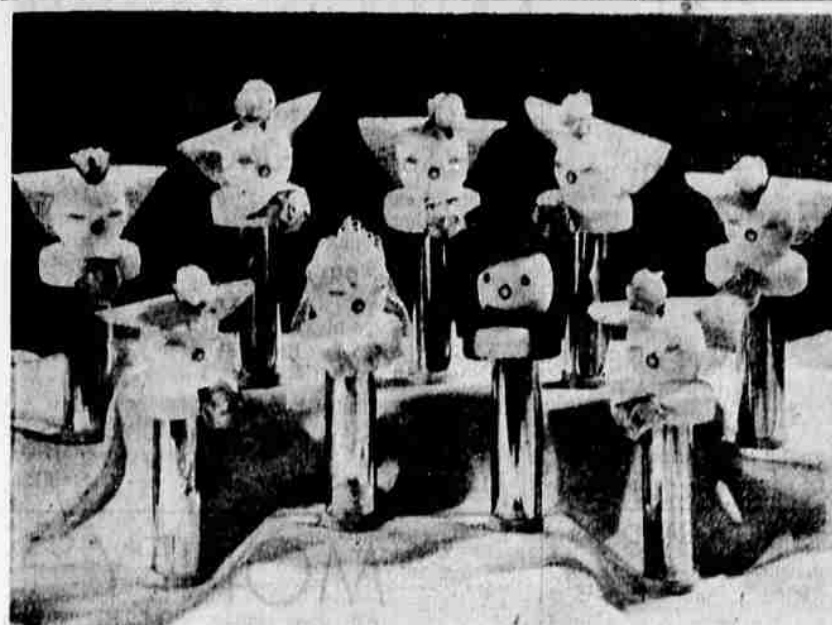

Expensive Pests

From the Klamath County Home Extension office comes word that copies of the publication, "Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles" (Home and Garden Bulletin No. 24) are available at the county extension office.

Clothes moths and carpet beetles are probably the most destructive household pests. They are responsible for some \$350 million in fabric damage each year. Now is the season to make sure none of your winter woollens and blankets will fall prey to these marauders this year.

Be sure that winter clothes are put away clean. Pests love to nest and chew in garments that aren't quite clean. Wash everything that is washable. All woolen blankets, coats, jackets, dresses, etc., should be well sunned before storing.

The home extension office recommends using EQ-43 in the laundry tub when laundering washable woollens such as sweaters, blankets, socks and scarfs.

If you use a cardboard or plywood wardrobe in the basement or attic for storage of winter woollens, moth repellents sprinkled on the floor of the wardrobe are effective. The wardrobe should be completely cleaned and sprayed with a bug bomb after airing and before it is used.

We are fortunate here in Klamath Falls in not having as much trouble with moths as people living in other places do. (You oughta live in Portland for a while — they breed even in the lawns there.)

The problem of amusing youngsters who are confined to bed may be eased by new greeting card creations which double as playthings. OUTDOOR LIGHTING

When the man of the house has an evening meeting, there is nothing much more comforting than a lighted driveway for him to come home to. For safety and convenience, G-E lighting specialists recommend a 150-watt projector floodlight like those you use for holiday lighting. Mount this weatherproof bulb in an outdoor-type holder under the eaves of the garage. Then, aim it on your driveway. Comes in mighty handy for identifying strange cars before you open the front door, too.



Planting after dark may not be your usual idea of when to get the garden in, but it does come in handy now and then. Rig up a handy portable light to see you through jobs you can't finish before dark. Lighting specialists suggest a 12-foot pole, spiked at one end and topped with a 150-watt projector spotlight and weatherproof, adjustable socket. Be sure to use weatherproof extension cords.

For those who have always wished they could mow their lawns after dark there are a couple of power mowers now on the market, complete with sealed beam "head lighting." These powerful little lamps provide a path of light to help you to see to cut the grass after dark. Idea probably comes from the household vacuum cleaner's spotlight.



Have you ever had a midnight hamburger spree outdoors? All you need to light your barbecue for night-time cooking is a 150-watt projector spotlight in a simple outdoor holder. It is suggested that you hang the lamp and holder on a nearby tree and aim it on the cooking grill. Use outdoor extension cords, connected to outdoor or garage electrical outlets.

For lighting the patio there are attractive new lights in the form of bird houses to hang in branches of trees. Lights which can be attached inside a garden umbrella are both colorful and useful. Low dome-shaped garden lights with spiked ends can be arranged along garden paths or in flower beds. For flood and spotlighting trees, shrubbery, barbecue grill or terrace, there is a wide variety of outdoor-type holders.

Except in spot or flood equipment, wherever you use 60-watt bulbs, you can discourage night-flying insects with G-E yellow bulbs. These yellow bulbs are just like ordinary household bulbs except that they have a special yellow coating. Bugs actually seem to

see yellow light the least, so they aren't attracted to it as easily as to the blue rays in regular bulbs.



A lighted backyard sports area is an invitation to teenagers to stay at home. Even the smallest backyard often has space for a pingpong table. For after-dark games, a pair of 150-watt projector spotlights, mounted on 12-foot poles at each end of the table give plenty of light for fast outdoor game. Use adjustable weatherproof sockets and wiring. Always aim the lights so they are on the table — not in the players' or neighbors' eyes.

If you are lighting your garden for the first time, be prepared for a pleasant thrill. For best results, here are a few hints to keep in mind:

1. Avoid spots of brightness from lighting units. Arrange them so spectators see only the "results," not how you did it. Simply conceal equipment in shrubs, tree branches or rocks.

2. Let darkness conceal unsightly views. It will be your biggest help, so depend on it. Actually, in many cases, views are improved at night because you can't see distracting sights.

3. If your house does not have permanent outdoor receptacles, use any protected outlet such as garage or porch light. The best plan, of course, is to have an electrician install a permanent outdoor outlet.

4. These reflector color lamps can also be used for flood-lighting your home at Christmas time.

To make sure the lamps don't break during a summer shower, where drops of water might touch the hot bulb, shield the bulb with a homemade hood of sheet metal. Some large cans also make good shields if they are large enough to allow the air to circulate freely.

PAINT PICTURES WITH LIGHT

Gardens can be as colorful by night as by day by the use of reflector color lamps. The new type of spot and flood bulbs have their own permanent color built right into them. Best of all, you don't have to be a lighting expert to use these, either.

The four basic colors, red, green, yellow, blue and two tints, blue-white and pink, may be mixed just as an artist mixes his colors. These colors can be diluted with white light from regular frosted R-40 150-watt spot or flood bulbs.

For instance, to enhance green trees, you would, of course, use green lamps. Then possibly, if you have geraniums or roses, try spotlighting them with red or pink. Simply place the 150-watt reflector color lamp of your choice in an outdoor-type holder and conceal it

The Fragile Look

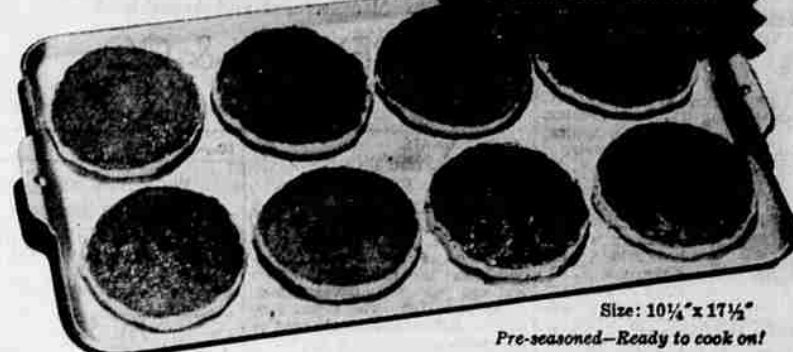
