

Ike Concerned By Slowness Of Congressional Action

WASHINGTON (AP)—President Eisenhower's decision to go to the people with his legislative program reportedly is based on growing administration concern over building a record for the campaign to maintain Republican control of Congress.

With the target date for adjournment of Congress just two months off and with November election campaigns already getting started, Eisenhower is pictured by associates as determined to do what he can to speed up the pace on his program.

He reflected such determination at his news conference yesterday.

1. Virtually barring from now on questions which deal with controversy over the activities of Sen. McCarthy (R-Wis.). Eisenhower has indicated several times he feels that controversy is diverting attention from the administration's program.

2. Saying that enactment of the program is so important to the welfare of the nation that he in-

tends to give it what he called his exclusive attention.

The President said he is going to talk about the program with everyone he sees—the public generally, members of Congress, and newsmen every time he meets with them.

He ticked off his proposals dealing with farm legislation, tax revision, foreign trade, health, housing and social security. In none of those fields has Congress completed action.

It has, in fact, approved only two major items in his program:

the St. Lawrence seaway and a highway construction program.

At earlier news conferences Eisenhower has indicated impatience over the pace with which his program is moving in Congress. And he has said the Republicans won't deserve to win in November unless

they can point to enactment of a dynamic and progressive program.

Eisenhower aides who asked not to be named said he plans to pound at a need for speedy action in just about every speech he makes during the next two months.

RESOLUTION NO. 813

A resolution declaring the intention of the Common Council to pave and improve, Grant Street from the Northeastern line of North Third Street to the southwestern line of North Fourth Street, exclusive of intersection and sidewalks, in the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, said project to be known as Improvement No. 122, and declaring and directing certain steps be taken in connection therewith.

Whereas, the City Engineer, pursuant to a resolution of the Common Council heretofore adopted, having filed plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of Grant Street from the Northeastern line of North Third Street to the Northwestern line of North Fourth Street, exclusive of intersection and sidewalks, in the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, and the Council finding the said plans, specifications and estimates satisfactory for said project, which shall be known as Improvement Unit No. 122.

Therefore, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon duly assembled in regular session, as follows:

Section I

That said plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of said portion of said street in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates shall be known as Improvement Unit No. 122.

That the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, hereby declares its intention to improve said portion of said street in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates as follows:

Type "A" To consist of paving street 4 1/2 inches in depth with Asphalt pavement together with cement curb and gutter, 26 feet in overall width, exclusive of Grant Street, Northeastern line of North Third Street to the Southwestern line of North Fourth Street, exclusive of intersection and sidewalks.

Type "B" To consist of paving street 4 1/2 inches in depth with concrete pavement together with cement curb and gutter, 26 feet in overall width, exclusive of Grant Street, Northeastern line of North Third Street to the Southwestern line of North Fourth Street, exclusive of intersection and sidewalks.

The cost of all classes of improvements embracing all work and materials for the complete improvement of said project for each type of pavement being as follows:

Type "A" Asphalt pavement \$4,763.40

Type "B" Cement pavement \$6,724.75

Section II

That the property lying within the boundaries hereinafter described be and it hereby is hereby declared to be benefited by the said improvement, to-wit:

Beginning at the most southern corner of lot 3 block 37 of First Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; thence easterly along the northeastern line of No. 3rd street to the most westerly corner of lot 6, Block 28 in said addition; thence northeasterly along the southeastern line of the alley in said block 28 to the most northern corner of lot 10 of said block 28; thence southeasterly on the southwestern line of No. 4th street to the most easterly corner of lot 1 of said block 27; thence southeasterly on the northwesterly line of the alley in said block 27 to the point of beginning.

That all the property included in the aforesaid boundaries above described be and it hereby is hereby declared to be benefited by said improvement and assessed for the expense thereof.

Section III

That Monday the 21st day of June, 1954, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock a.m., and the Council Chamber of the City Hall in Klamath Falls, Oregon, be and it hereby is fixed as the time and place for hearing of objections and remonstrances against said proposed improvement.

Section IV

That the Police Judge be and he is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by the City Charter of said City and shall publish this resolution as provided by law, and within five days after the first publication thereof the City Engineer shall cause to be conspicuously posted at each end of the line of contemplated improvement such notice as is provided for by law and ordinance.
