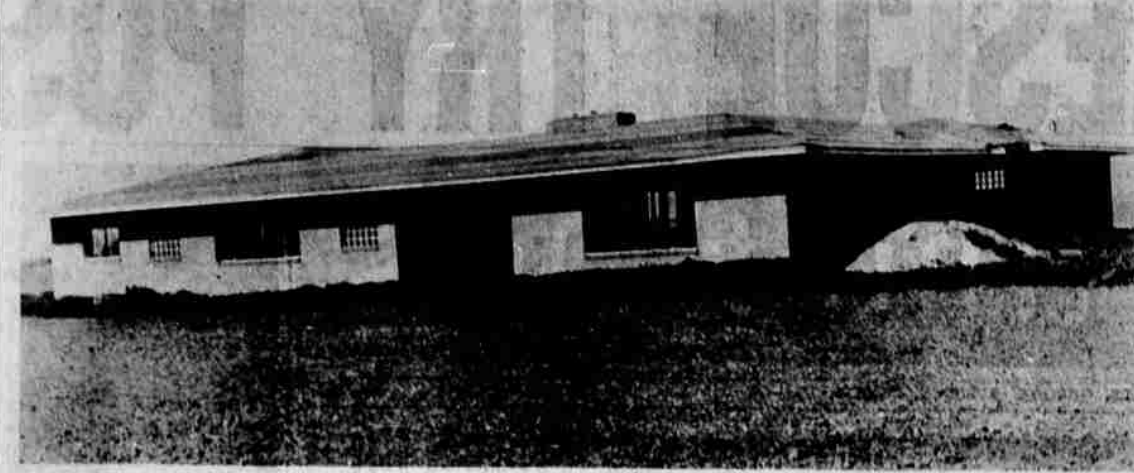

**Vice Investigation Ends In Trial**

NEWPORT, Ore. (AP) — Otto Cahill, a central figure in the recent Lincoln County vice investigation, will be brought to trial in Polk County.

He is accused of taking \$750 from funds of a Lincoln County water district. His attorney said that recent publicity over the vice investigation would make it impossible for Cahill to have a fair trial in Lincoln County. The request for a change of venue was granted Monday.

Cahill was one of the leaders in the group demanding the vice probe. The indictment against him was the only one returned by the grand jury which made the investigation.

Cahill has denied the charge.

**New Funds For Interior Needs Eyed**

WASHINGTON (AP) — The House and Senate Tuesday were \$63,263,007 apart on recommended appropriations to finance operations of the Department of the Interior in the year beginning July 1.

The Senate completed action on the bill Monday, approving on a vote expenditure of \$427,601,006 by the department—as compared with House-voted appropriations of \$364,337,989. The difference will be resolved by a conference between the two bodies, unless the House agrees to the Senate version.

Largest single item in the bill is for project construction by the Bureau of Reclamation. For this the Senate allowed \$132,977,127 in new money as compared with the House's \$114,470,700.

In passing the bill, the Senate made no changes in recommendations made by its Appropriations Committee in reporting the bill last week.

Several possible amendments were discussed but were not pushed to a vote.

Sen. Humphrey (D-Minn.) took the floor to assail the \$27,880,099 proposed for the Park Service as being totally inadequate.

Declaring the Park Service is the "forgotten child" of the government, he told the Senate that roads and facilities of national recreation areas are rapidly deteriorating.

"Congress is not as interested in Yellowstone Park as it is in building officers' clubs and golf courses," he said.

Major appropriation items in the bill for the various offices and bureaus of the Interior Department were:

Bonneville Power Administration \$25,000,000; Bureau of Land Management \$15,413,000; Bureau of Indian Affairs \$84,417,500; Bureau of Reclamation (all activities including construction) \$164,190,127; geological survey \$25,860,000; Bureau of Mines \$19,000,000; Fish and Wildlife Service \$11,667,000 and Office of Territories \$37,800,000.

**Pair Wed On Canada Border**

DETROIT (AP)—Two German immigrants spoke their marriage vows yesterday at the international boundary on the Ambassador Bridge, connecting Detroit and Windsor, Ont.

After the ceremony, Herbert B. Riedel, 38, went back to Windsor, where he is a hospital orderly. Mrs. Valeria M. Unger, 40, returned to Chicago, where she works for a meat-packing company.

Riedel has been unable to come to the United States because quotas have been filled. Mrs. Unger who has a son by a previous marriage, went to Chicago in March 1953. Now the two are hoping the marriage will shorten his separation from his bride.
