Duck's Homing Habits Reported

Banded wood duck hens returning to nesting sites on Sauvie and Government islands are displaying homing instincts never before realized. A total of 88 female woodies were banded during the spring of 1963 by Al Hoffmeister, biologist at Sauvie Island. Since May 5, 19 of these hens have been recovered at the wood duck nesting boxes, and 13 of them have returned to the same nesting box used last year. Any doubts as to the suitability of the artificially constructed homesites should be dispelled by this observation.

In addition to last year's tenants, 48 newcomers have been banded on their nests. Hens are sitting on a clutch of eggs averaging 12 to 14 in size. Already 162 of the nest boxes are in use by wood ducks, and it is expected that others of the 350 in place on the two islands will be used before the season is over. A couple of barn owls have set up housekeeping in one of the houses,

and flying squirrels, bees, sparrow hawks, and tree swallows are using others.

Stolen Plane Wreck Found

ALBANY, Ore. (AP)—An airplane stolen from Eugene six years ago was found wrecked in the Cascade Mountains east of here Monday with the skeletal remains of one or more persons inside.

Sheriff George Miller of Linn County headed a party going to the scene, 65 miles east of here, to try to identify the person or persons killed in the crash.

The man who was accused of stealing the plane on May 23, 1946, was William D. Bousquet, 24, Eugene, who has not been seen since.

The light plane was stolen from Green's Flying Service at the Eugene Airport. Whether the pilot crashed in his flight from Eugene or whether he crashed later was not determined.

There was a report at the time that the pilot intended to go to Tacoma. The FBI investigated and said several persons at Tacoma reported seeing the next day a plane that resembled the one taken from Eugene. The information was meager, however, and the FBI said it was not determined whether anyone was with the pilot when that plane left Tacoma on May 24, 1946.

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
