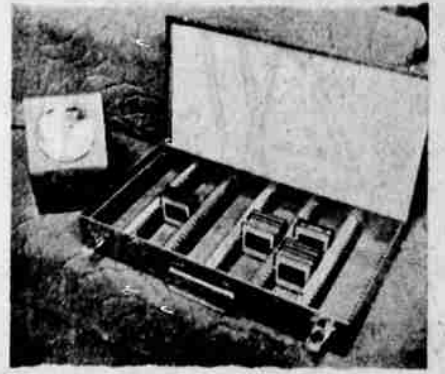
Anglers Warned To Return Fish Punch Cards

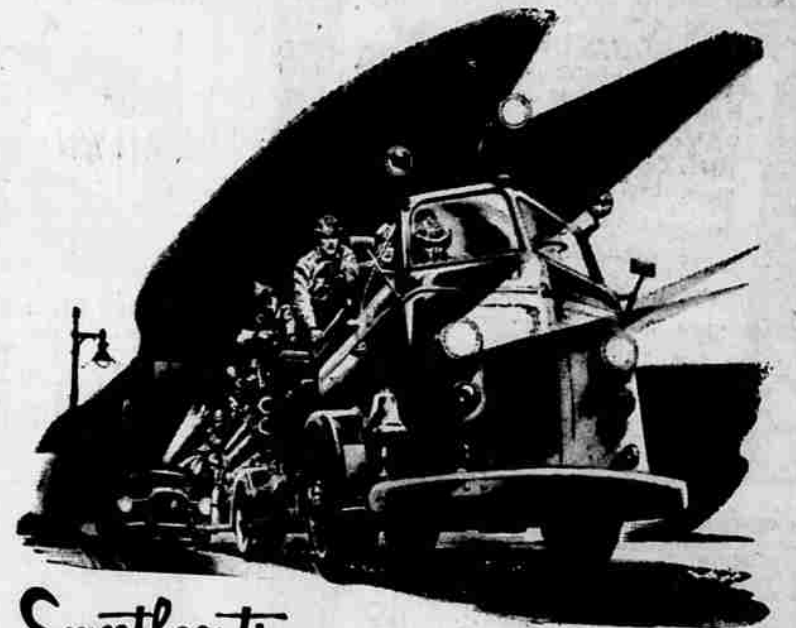
