

BPA, Copco Hold Meeting

A. S. Cunningham, president of The California Oregon Power Company and J. C. Boyle, Operations vice president, conferred with the officials of the Bonneville Power Administration early this week in Medford concerning inter-change of energy between the two systems.

The discussion covered the operation of the Yamsay-Klamath Falls line and service to the Oregon coastal area and the recently completed Hanna Plant at Riddle.

The Redmond - Yamsay - Klamath Falls line, while not yet in full service last Friday, spectacularly demonstrated its value to the area. John D. Davis, Assistant Administrator of BPA, said that had not the line been in partial service, substantial inconvenience and economic loss would have occurred in the Bend-Redmond Area, due to an outage of the BPA System feeding the Central Oregon Area from the North.

Mr. Davis expressed BPA appreciation to the California Oregon Power Company for their co-operation and assistance in making Copco power available over the line and thereby aiding in restoring service.

While the Copco officials made light of the service rendered, the incident dramatically illustrates the benefits to be expected through inter-connection and whole-hearted cooperation.
