Most men like to cook and the trend toward outdoor living makes it easier for the man of the house to take over culinary activities. Probably more men would prepare meals if it were not for the horrid task of washing the dishes after a meal.

The secret of less work — whether the meal is to be served in your own backyard or patio or at your summer cottage at the lake or beach — lies no farther away than the nearest supermarket. Three ready-to-hand items do a good job for the family chef. You'll find paper service, including all varieties of plates, aluminum foil and plastic cutlery — all are available in any size to fit your needs. After use, the paper goes directly into the rubbish bucket or burns merrily in the outdoor or indoor fireplace.
