Potato Crop Said Lower

Some interesting early estimates on the potato situation nationally appears in a late issue of the Spud Light, according to Extension Agent C. A. Henderson. In part the statement says: "Potato crops in the summer states are eight per cent under last year. . . . The late spring crop now passing its peak is estimated at 35.4 million bushels, 23 per cent less than last year. . . . This year's total production of early commercial potatoes, early spring and summer is estimated at 38.2 million bushels, down 19 per cent from last season. . . . In California

the late spring crop is about 25 per cent under last year. The unknown quantity is the main late crop which supplies by far the greater part of the nation's potatoes. Cordon Reports Labor Survey

WASHINGTON—Senator Guy Cordon said today that for the 16th consecutive month under the Eisenhower administration, federal employment declined during April. "In all, during the first 10 months of the current fiscal year, ending June 30, federal employment decreased by 134,344 persons," Cordon said after reviewing a report by the Joint Congressional Committee on Non-essential Expenditures. The survey covered civilian employees both at home and abroad in the executive agencies of the government. As of May 1, this payroll totalled \$2,335,296. A decrease of 4,841 in the April payroll, while small, nevertheless marked the 16th straight month under Republican administration in which payroll reductions were reported, Cordon said.
