Wagner has spent much of his life in the newspaper business and the publishing field. He owned the Lakeview Herald in 1905 and came to Klamath Falls the following year to become the first city editor of the old Klamath Express, when J.

Scott Taylor was publisher of the weekly. Later he became city editor of the Evening Herald, a daily. From here he went to San Francisco in 1914 to go into the real estate business. Later he returned to the publishing field, filling important posts on numerous newspapers, on the Wall Street Journal, in administrative positions for the federal government during World War II, and as a free lance writer. For the past several years he has filled executive positions with the National Jewelers Association.

Mrs. Wagner, who spent her early life here, has just had a volume of poems, "Roots," published by The Wings Press, which has received acclaim of critics as a brilliant anthology.

Mr. Wagner is returning to New York by plane. Mrs. Wagner will

be joined here in early July by a daughter, Mrs. Eleanor Post, and her young son, Edward William

Post, for a trip to Chicago by automobile.

The Wagner family home is near New York.
