European Rotary Club Expands

MARBURG, Germany - Rotary International, which the Soviet Union forbids in the Communist bloc, is growing fast along the Iron Curtain. West Germany's 66th Rotary Club has just received its charter in Marburg.

This American-conceived movement for friendship among nations was introduced in Germany in 1927. Adolf Hitler banned it and dissolved 40 clubs in 1934 after he had assumed dictatorial power. When the West German Republic was set up in 1949, Rotary came back.

Total German membership now exceeds 2,000. Five or six new
