Summer is picnic time. Picnics mean home cooking and that means preparing and packing. Today packing picnic fare is made much easier with a large size extra deep covered cake pan with a self-locking cover.

Not just for picnics, you'll use the pan in your own kitchen. It is just the right size for package mix cake. Cut the cake through the center for a square, two-layer cake. It saves the washing of a second cake pan.

The Foley kitchens recommended this recipe for Brownies to take on your next picnic or for serving at home. There is plenty of room in the deep pan for delicious thick frosting.

BROWNIES

- 4 eggs, beaten until very fluffy
- 2 cups sugar, gradually sifted into eggs
- 1/2 cup butter melted with 4 squares chocolate

Add the butter and chocolate to the sugar-egg combination. Then add 1 cup of cake flour (not sifted) 1/2 cup chopped nuts, vanilla and a pinch of salt. Bake about one-half hour at 325 to 350 degrees, or until top of cake springs back when pressed with finger.

Roll Call of Colors Troop Into Fashion

"These hottest colors ever to take over sports clothes—shorts, shirts, beach hats, tops, swim suits, skirts — make no rhyme or reason or apology to the Southwest Indians for the company they keep.

A pink shirt, sage purple shorts may keep company with a poison green hat. A turquoise top and a pair of violet pedal pushers may wander off together. Brown, blue and orange may unite happily into one outfit.

"The question that's put to me," says Max Factor Jr., "is what sane make-up rule applies to this crazy quilt of colors when as many as three aggressive ones

meet in the same costume?" His answer? If your costume includes a hat, make up to it. If it's a poison green hat, dramatize your eyes to make the most of the greenish light and mysterious shadows. Not to make up your eye, warns Factor, will make them look sickly under such eerie reflections of light.

Since there's bound to be a lot of yellow in a poison green hat, key your lipstick to it and wear a yellowish red or golden flame shade.

With a turquoise and violet combination of colors, wear lipstick containing blue, says Factor, he suggests, however, a definite warm blue that has rich overtones of red.

An outfit trooping such colors as brown, blue and orange should be worn with the reddest, hottest, orange lipstick you own Factor maintains. Your most aggressive costume color — orange — must be played up, he says, with an almost matching bright lipstick of golden flame.
