Buy it when you do your regular marketing and keep it ready for use in the freezing compartment of your refrigerator.

Quick Tricks With Ice Cream

Times change. Not too many years ago, the main outlet for ice cream was the fountain and drug store. Today the food store exceeds all other outlets for ice cream sales. Along with this greater availability of ice cream goes increased use.

When the temperature begins to soar, desserts that are quick and easy to prepare and don't require turning on the oven are in demand. Rich, smooth ice cream is the perfect answer. Serve it alone or

fixed up with a little quick fixin'. Ladyfingers, cup cakes and sponge cake rings are handy items to serve with vanilla or other flavored ice cream. Topping may be fresh red raspberries, crushed and sweetened. They have been particularly luscious on the local market for the last couple of weeks and have dropped from the first peak price of expensiveness.

Quality of the strawberries coming in has improved and it won't be long before we have fresh

peaches. Or, you can use any of the numerous frozen berries or fruit to be found in your grocer's frozen food section. Klamath Falls is fortunate in having fine markets.

The fact that ice cream is a nutritious food should be gratifying for the many who rate it as their favorite dessert. Ice cream contains significant amounts of protein, calcium, vitamin A and riboflavin.

COOLNESS IN A GLASS

CHERRY FRAPPE
1 can (6 oz.) fresh-frozen lemonade
1/2 cup cherry or cranberry juice
Water
Finely crushed ice
Fresh cherries

Blend lemonade with water, following label directions. Mix with cherry or cranberry juice. Pour over finely crushed ice and garnish with fresh cherries. Yield should be 4 1/2 cups of juice.

PEACH SUPREME
1 can (12 oz.) fresh-frozen orange juice
3 cans water
1 pint peach ice cream
1 cup milk
Fresh peach slices (when available)

Blend fresh-frozen orange juice with water, following label directions. Allow ice cream to soften a little, then mix with juice. Beat in milk. Serve in tall glasses and garnish with fresh peach slices. Makes approximately 10 servings. (This is rushing the season just a little, but we'll have peaches pretty soon!)

GRAPE FREEZE
1 can (6 oz.) fresh-frozen lemonade
1 can (6 oz.) fresh-frozen grape juice
1 pint lemon sherbet
Water

Blend fresh-frozen lemonade and fresh-frozen grape juice with water, following label directions. Mix and pour over ice cubes in tall glasses and top with lemon sherbet. Serves six to eight.

SEAFOAM BAKING

Try this with your spice cake mix cake. In a small saucepan, mix 1 cup brown sugar, 1/4 cup light corn syrup and 1/4 cup water. Boil slowly until syrup spins a 4 to 6-inch thread. Remove from heat. Beat two egg whites until stiff enough to hold a peak. Pour syrup in a fine stream into egg whites, beating all the time. Continue beating until thick enough to spread. Enough for an 8 or 9-inch layer cake.
