### KF Family Holds Reunion

An apple tree and two Juniper trees, that still stand in the Yalta Gardens division in the South Suburban district, made shade many years ago for the children in the Abraham Turner family. Six members of that family, five sisters and a brother, gathered recently to reminisce and to visit the old home site.

They were W. A. Turner, Portland, Mrs. R. H. Sewell, Crescent City, California, Mrs. Maud Chris-

tensen, Klamath Falls, Mrs. Inez Short, Henley, Mrs. C. M. Kirkpatrick and Mrs. Emma Wilson, both of Malin.

Their parents, Mr. and Mrs. Turner and the two eldest daughters, now Mrs. Wilson and Mrs. Short came to Linkville in 1888 from Woodburn, Oregon. Turner took over farming interests on the Crossen Smith estate, land which is now covered by homes.

Mrs. Smith and Turner were sister and brother. The family occupied the farm until 1919 when Turner, a native of London, England, died. Mrs. Turner made her home with Mrs. Christensen until her death in 1938.

Inez was the first of the family to marry. She became Mrs. R. C. Short in 1902. Linkville had by then become Klamath Falls. The couple moved to Henley where they cleared and farmed one of the first ranches in the Henley district. Mrs. Short still lives there.

Emma was married to the late Harry Wilson, prominent Malin farmer in 1904. They took up home-

stead land in 1910 which is still owned by the family.

Mr. and Mrs. Kirkpatrick were married in 1907 and moved immediately to their farm in Malin, now owned by a son, Orville.

Walter Turner continued to farm the homeplace until 1935 when he

and his family moved to Portland.

In 1914 Ella became Mrs. Sewell. She and her husband lived in Klamath Falls until 1948 when they moved to the coast.

Maude and Martin Christensen married in 1918. Mrs. Christensen, except for brief intervals has

made her home in Klamath Falls.

Seventy three direct descendants of the five sisters including great-grandchildren are living, most of them in the Klamath Basin.

Fifty five persons attended the family reunion at the home of Mrs. Short, in Henley, on July 1.
