Segregation Dodge Sought

JACKSON, Miss. (AP)—A state constitutional amendment opening the door for abolishing public schools was recommended by Mississippi's committee seeking ways to dodge the U.S. Supreme Court decision outlawing racial segregation in public education.

Gov. Hugh White said yesterday he would call the Legislature into special session early in September to consider the proposed amendment to Mississippi's 64-year-old Constitution.

It would authorize the Legislature by a two-thirds vote to abolish public schools, statewide or on a local option basis, if necessary to maintain segregation.

Members of Mississippi's Legal Education Advisory Committee declared it would be used only as a last resort.

The amendment is viewed as a safeguard if Negroes try to force school integration. It could be held over their heads as a threat—cooperate or lose your public schools.

Private, segregated schools with state aid could be set up under the amendment, which would wipe out the present constitutional requirement that public schools be provided.

The advisory committee said it would recommend that the Legislature get started on a building program to improve Negro schools but only if the proposed constitutional amendment were approved for protection.

Army Exchanges Plan Price Cuts

TOKYO (AP)— Servicemen and their families in Japan and Korea will find prices a bit lower in Army post exchanges next month.

Post exchanges are not allowed to make a profit and must lower prices when business gets too good. An "odd cent" price reduction set for Aug. 1 will cut prices to the nearest 5-cent figure. And profits from cheap, fast-selling merchandise such as candy bars, which cannot be reduced 5 cents, will make greater cuts possible on more expensive items, the Army said.

Morse Blocks Picket Bill

WASHINGTON (AP)— Sen. Morse (Ind-Ore) Tuesday blocked a bill to forbid picketing in the streets surrounding the White House.

"I don't propose to be a party to police state methods in the United States," Morse said.

He cast his own vote and the proxy vote of the absent Sen. Neely (D-W. Va.) at a public hearing to provide the 2-1 margin by which a Senate District of Columbia subcommittee shelved the measure.

The out-voiced chairman, Sen. Reynolds (R-Neb.), announced he would file a minority report on the action with the full district committee, which could revive the legislation.

Rep. Centry (D-Texas), author of the House-passed bill, testified it had its beginning in what he termed "the disgusting and revolting spectacle" of a picket line that ringed the White House grounds last year in futile appeals for the condemned atomic spies, Julius and Ethel Rosenberg. The two spies finally were electrocuted.
