WEED - The Tulelake Air Force Reserve Flight had a joint meeting with the Weed Flight here Wednesday evening.

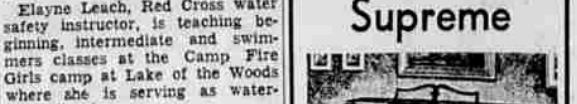
