### RC Aquatic School Slated

Swimming, boating and first aid enthusiasts from the eight western states are rapidly filling the student enrollment lists for the national aquatic school of the American Red Cross to be held at Lake of the Woods August 22 to September 1. The local Red Cross office has received information that students who wish to "live out" of the camp can register for the instruction by a payment of a \$15.00 fee for the ten days instruction. Fee schedule for meals at the camp includes \$1.00 breakfast, \$1.00 lunch and \$1.25 for dinner for those who may wish to take part of their meals with the student group. It is hoped that many local residents, particularly Lake of the Woods home owners, will avail themselves of the opportunity.

Students must be 18 years of age; if they register for aquatics they should be good swimmers. Courses offered include advanced swimming, life saving, boating, canoeing, small craft, First Aid and accident prevention. If there is sufficient demand the course will also include synchronized swimming and water ballet and water therapy work with the handicapped. Those coming to specialize in first aid need not take any water work unless they wish.

A fee of \$45.00 covers room, board, tuition and school supplies for the ten day course. Application blanks are available at the local Red Cross office in the Armory.

### Marriage Policy Adopted By School

HOT SPRINGS, Ark. (AP)—The Hot Springs School Board has adopted a policy that high school students planning to marry and continue in school must notify the principal in writing at least two weeks before the wedding.

Klamath County wheat growers will vote on wheat marketing quotas on Friday, July 23, according to County Extension Agent C. A. Henderson. All wheat growers who will have over 15 acres of wheat next year are eligible to vote. Growers having 15 acres or less won't be affected by quotas.

### Russians Try To Convince World Of Their 'Normalcy'

By WILLIAM L. RYAN AP Foreign News Analyst The Russians have unveiled a new weapon in the cold war. It is the normal look. Trapped in a monumental bureaucracy, the Soviets are attempting to convince the world that they are just as normal as anybody else, if not more so.

The ruling Communist regime is attempting the impossible in trying to persuade Russians to avoid alcoholic stimulants — the same stimulants downed with such vigor by the big shots. The ordinary Ivan is just as fond of his Vodka as Molotov is.

Outside their borders they have had some success. Their cultural offensive has prospered. Dozens of Soviet writers, artists and athletes have sallied forth — under unobtrusive surveillance — to spread the word that the Soviet Union's regime is interested only in making the world one big, happy family. In turn, the Russians have dusted off the welcome mat for many a tourist from abroad.

The official press expresses concern for the sanctity of the home. Divorces are harder to get. Only recently young Communists were instructed in their official journal that jealousy no longer is to be regarded as a "bourgeois survival" but a proper emotion for the new Soviet man protecting his happiness. All this may serve to convince

some in the outside world that Russia is becoming more normal. But at home people must be confused.
