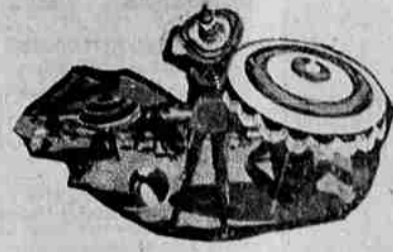




SUMMERTIME
