

# Neuberger Hits Farm Policies

RENDERSON 18 — Richard L. Neuberger, Democratic nominee for the U. S. Senate, criticized the Eisenhower administration's farm policies in a talk to some 200 persons at a Democratic rally here Wednesday night.

He said, "Farm income is sagging seriously, so that a sharp reduction in the government's per-capita program might trigger an economic collapse which could adversely affect every citizen in the nation."

Neuberger argued that lower support prices would not benefit the consumer, who he said has been "propagandized about the so-called killing made by farm people."

A loaf of bread costing 20 cents contains only 2 cents worth of wheat, so that a 15 per cent drop in farm prices would lower the cost of a loaf by only four-tenths of a cent, he said.

"Would this trivial saving even be passed on to the housewife?" Neuberger asked. "Look what happened when taxes on theater and baseball tickets were reduced."

# Air Force Plans Catering System

RENDERSON 18 — A popular lunch of Civilians, military and Air Force Base personnel.

They are the advance guard of National Food Services Inc., a Chicago catering firm, which will do up the base on an experimental basis for 11 months beginning Aug. 1.

Nationwide, under the contract, will furnish all kitchen police and cooks while the Air Force furnishes the food and equipment.

This is the Defense Department's first such experiment to determine whether private contractors can do the job cheaper than the military.

**Sons, Husband Lost By Woman**

ANCHORAGE, Alaska 18—Once there were five in the fishing Smith family.

Then in the early 1930s Mrs. Mary Smith's husband drowned at the family fishing site near Tyonek, 60 miles west of Anchorage. His body never was recovered.

The widow, who thrived on to rear, continued to go annually to the fishing grounds, superintending operations during the season until the boys were able to take over.

Three years ago one of the sons, Roland, drowned at the same spot his father had perished.

Last year, another son, Byron, drowned on a hunting trip on the Olympic Peninsula in the state of Washington.

Gerard, 26, the last of the sons, carried on, Monday, his body, his bow above in like it had struck a barge or scow, was found at the spot where father and brother had died. His body has not been recovered.

Now Mrs. Smith, almost totally blind, alone remains.
