



Save That Rug

In a year's time the offspring from only six moths can eat the weight of a baby grand piano, the National Institute of Rug Cleaning warns.

Fortunately, here in the high desert there are fewer moths than in some other localities where the altitude is lower.

Summer months are the worst season for moths and carpet beetles which feast on wool rugs and carpets. A year ago the U. S. Department of Agriculture estimated that moths and beetles would ruin between 200 and 500 million dollars' worth of fabrics. There is no indication, says NIRC, that this pest threat will be any less in the next 12 months.

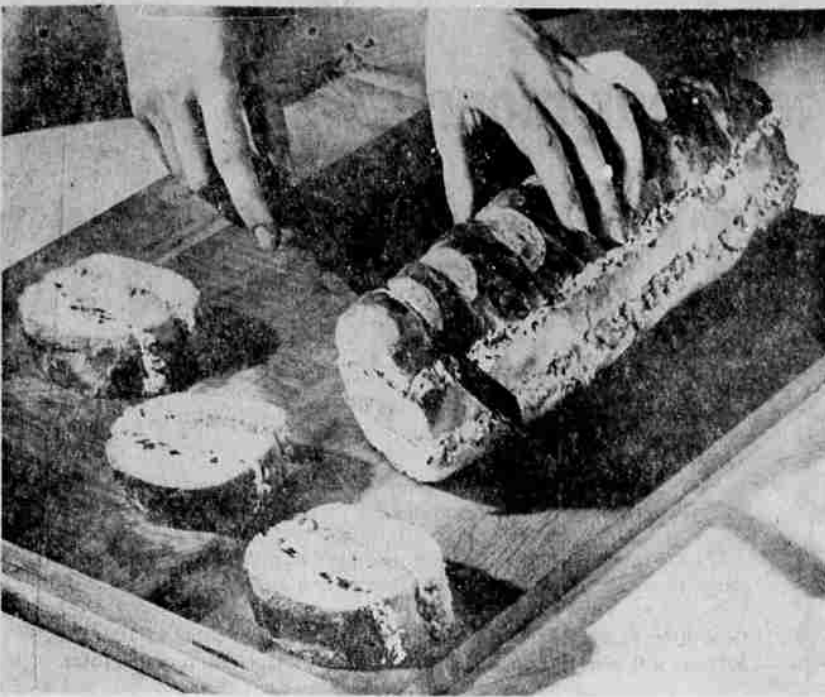
Under high temperatures and humidity, moth eggs hatch rapidly. The resulting larvae gorge themselves for 40 days. And the greedier, tougher beetle larvae will banquet for a whole year. Moths and beetles abhor sunlight and are quite delighted to settle in a home where blinds and curtains are drawn, either because of sun or because the owners are vacationing.

The best protection against moths and carpet beetles is a thorough professional rug cleaning. Again, residents of Klamath Falls are fortunate in having fine rug cleaning service available here.

The professional rug cleaner can mothproof rugs and carpets during their annual cleaning. This service will also kill silverfish which attack jute and cotton backing.

The vacuum cleaner and carpet sweeper should not be neglected in the fight and should be used several times a week. Daily care is even better. Breaks, creases, seams, folds and baseboard areas should be given special attention. Each is a likely hiding place for voracious eaters.

When you leave for vacation, it is a good plan to use household insecticide spray at the top of clothes closets and along the floor, backs of heavy drapes and beneath heavy furniture.



THIS SANDWICH is no dainty tea-time trifle but a satisfying man-type dish, complete with all the crispy crust found only on French bread. This hearty treat for family or guests is prepared in advance, chilled, and sliced as needed. The recipe and picture come from Betty Crocker Kitchen of General Mills, Inc.

HEARTY SANDWICH

Combine 1 cup diced chicken, 1 cup ground ham and 1/4 cup chopped celery, mixing lightly. Add 1/2 cup mayonnaise, 2 teaspoons horseradish, 1/2 teaspoon salt and a dash of pepper, mixing well. Spread 6 slices of bread with butter or margarine and chicken-ham filling. Top with 6 more bread slices.

FINNIGAN'S FAVORITE

This Beef Bake was developed especially for August - National Sandwich Month. Arrange 4 slices of bread in bottom of 9-inch square baking pan. Spread with butter or margarine. Spoon 2 cups corned beef generously over the bread. Spread 4 more slices of bread with mustard. Place the bread, mustard

side down, on corned beef. Combine 1 1/2 cups condensed tomato soup (10 1/2-oz. can), 1/2 cup water, 1/4 cup chopped onion and 1/2 teaspoon horseradish. Mix thoroughly. Pour over sandwiches. Bake in moderately hot oven (400 degrees) 20 minutes. Makes 4 sandwiches.

Poor Boy's Sandwich

1 large loaf French bread
Soft butter
Two 3-oz. packages of cream cheese
1 tablespoon milk
1/2 cup chopped ripe olives
2 cups ground cooked ham or 1 12-oz. can luncheon meat
2-3 cup diced cucumber
1/4 teaspoon salt
1-3 cup mayonnaise
Slice bread lengthwise, making three layers. Spread with soft butter. Mix cream cheese, milk and olives; spread over first layer. Mix ham, cucumber, salt, mayonnaise; spread over second layer. Put three layers together and wrap loaf in waxed paper. Chill in refrigerator. Just before serving, slice diagonally into 1-inch wide sandwiches and place on table as a loaf.
