TL Ambulance Funds Sought

TULELAKE—A porchlight campaign to raise funds for the purchase of a modern ambulance, sponsored by the 20-30 Club will get under way, Tuesday, August 21, and will continue through September 3, according to co-chairmen Harry Santos and DeRoy Simpson.

The vehicle will be presented to the city of Tulelake.

All members of the club will assist with the fund raising. Donations will be sought from organizations and individuals. Lighted porches will indicate that a contribution is waiting.

The ambulance will be manned by 20-30 Club members.

The present ambulance in use for eight years is still answering calls but is inadequate in both size and speed. The 20-30 Club, desiring to improve the ambulance service, inaugurated the move to buy a new one.

The vehicle now in use is

equipped to handle two patients. The new one will care for three. A respirator is carried with the ambulance on all runs.

Service runs will include communities of Tulelake, Merrill, Malin, Newell and Tionesta and the ambulance will be available anywhere in Southern Oregon or Northern California in disaster call.

The campaign is rated as the largest fund drive ever attempted here by an organization.

Estimated cost of the new service car is \$6,000.

Farm Ammonia Supply Told

For the first time since the ammonia boom began in the Northwest, the needs of Oregon, Washington and Idaho for agricultural and industrial ammonia can now be amply supplied by Pacific Coast production, and by late this year the Northwest will have liquid ammonia storage facilities located in the center of its markets, according to G. R. Monkhouse, vice president of Shell Chemical Corporation's ammonia division.

The increased supply is due to the opening of new plants, such as the one opened in Ventura, California, last year, plus expanded facilities of other producers in the West and Canada.

The storage terminals in the Northwest, on which Shell began major construction this week, are designed to provide the area with upwards of 50,000 tons of ammonia a year. The ammonia will be manufactured at Shell's plant in Pittsburg, California, and shipped by ocean-going barges to the Portland terminal, where part of the cargo will be stored and part transhipped to Pasco, Wash. Railroad tank cars will carry the products from Pasco and Portland to Northwest markets.
