

Legion Drum Corps To Hold Talent Show August 20-21

Cabbie Dies From Stabbing

CHICAGO (AP)—Sheriff's officers said a Washington Park stablehand stabbed a cab driver to death in the race track parking lot last night and then went for a stroll with the victim's wife.

Dead is Harry R. Andrews, Captain Jack Johnson of the

County sheriff's police said Jack Miller, 28-year-old stablehand, stabbed Andrews nine times with a three-inch-blade pocket knife as Andrews' wife, Mary, 41, watched.

Johnson described Miller as being friendly with Mrs. Andrews. The officer said Andrews followed

the couple into the parking lot of the South Side race track, pleading with his wife to return to him. As Andrews continued toward them, Johnson said, Miller took the knife out of his pocket and killed the taxi driver. Johnson

quoted Miller as saying Andrews hit him first with a pop bottle. Then, Johnson said, Miller and Mrs. Andrews continued their walk. They were arrested on a street three blocks away. Johnson said Miller admitted the

stabbing. Miller and Mrs. Andrews were held without charge.
