Big German Food Plan Announced

BONN, Germany. (AP)—A vast project to boost food production in West Germany is ready to go into operation.

The plan also aims at consolidating the scattered plots owned by many farmers into unbroken fields better adapted to machinery.

Nevertheless, densely populated, highly industrialized West Germany still consumes 35 per cent more food than her farms produce.

Increasing farm production in Germany is a problem that at first sight appears almost unsolvable.

One of West Germany's foremost agricultural experts, Dr. Andreas Herms, who heads the powerful German Farmers Union, endorses the Luebbe plan wholeheartedly.

Neither Luebbe nor Herms consider such a radical solution. Both believe the small farm, as a family enterprise, is justified.

Jet Engineers Hold Meetings

SEATTLE (AP)—The men who design and build America's jet airplane engines took stock of their work Tuesday and pronounced the progress encouraging—with great obstacles yet to be overcome.

And here, at the "national turbo-jet engineering" of the Institute of Aeronautical Sciences, there was a surprising emphasis on a somewhat less glamorous cousin of the pure jet engine—the turbo-prop, a design in which jet turbine engines are used to drive propellers.

Tax Revision Gives More Deductions To U.S. Farmer

WASHINGTON (AP)—A farmer can now get a tax cut by building himself a pond, ... or digging a ditch.

This is one of the special effects of the huge tax revision law. In passing out scores of tax benefits, Congress didn't forget the farmer in this congressional election year.

The law permits a farmer to deduct from his income, on tax returns, many outlays for soil or water conservation. Even at the minimum 20 per cent tax rate, each \$100 in new deductions means a tax cut of \$20.
