FRANKFURT, Germany (B—A) mark claim of treason and widespread unrest tortured West Germany's nerves today.

For the first time in its five year history, the Bonn republic has shown signs of wavering in its vaunted discipline, industriousness and unity.

Million low-paid workers in industry, agriculture and even government are massing behind union leaders to get more money or walk out.

Strikes this week by 15,000 Hamburg public utility employees and a number of the 220,000 metal workers in Bavaria are a warning for worse to come unless management and labor jointly begin talking reason.

Many old political wounds among the German people have reopened by the desertion to the Soviet zone of Dr. Otto John, the West Ger-

man security chief.

A wartime anti-Nazi and post-war British agent, John strained Allied-German relations by his startling defection to the East.

For West Germany's enemies throughout the world, John is now supplying fresh propaganda charges that the Bonn government is Nazified and a menace to peace.

For Soviet spy chiefs, John is a potential gold mine of information about the West's security agents.

He is the man who went to dinner in Washington just two months ago with Allen Dulles, director of the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency, and who conferred with FBI Chief J. Edgar Hoover and high American military officers at the Pentagon.

West German officials insist he was told nothing of great importance but have not minimized the seriousness of his defection.
