Airline Workers To Be Laid Off

NEW YORK (AP) — Nearly 10,000 employees of the American Airlines will be laid off by the end of the month unless a strike of pilots is ended quickly.

President C. B. Smith sent a notice to airline personnel Thursday saying he regretted very much the necessity for such action but that the strike left no alternative.

The line employs more than 15,000 persons and has a monthly payroll of more than 7 million dollars. All but a few maintenance people and guards would be dropped.
