### Field Training School Held

The first training school for field personnel of the Oregon State Game Commission was held in the old Camp Adair area north of Corvallis this past week.

Although separate fish and game conferences have been held for many years this was the first time that field workers and supervisory personnel in all categories were brought together at one session.

One of the primary purposes of the conference is to provide an opportunity for each of those attending to learn more about the work of others. A game commission representative, no matter what his specialty may be, is expected by the public to be able to answer questions on all phases of commission operations.

In addition, the school is designed to evaluate field techniques, assimilate new ideas, and discuss problems of mutual interest.

Among outside speakers contributing to the session were Clarence Pautske, chief of fisheries for the Washington Game Department, and Dr. Lytle Calvin, statistician with the Oregon State Experiment Station.

More than 125 men participated in the training school which will be an annual affair.
