### U. S. Fleet Stands Guard Against Red China Threat

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. H. Alexander Smith (R-N.J.) said today the American 7th Fleet should be able to block any Chinese Communist attempt to invade the is-

land of Formosa. "The Communists might be able to mass thousands of sampans which could be ominous," Smith said in an interview. "But they could never cross against the modern naval vessels of our 7th Fleet. We're not worried about that."

Smith, chairman of the Far East subcommittee of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, approved President Eisenhower's declaration yesterday that any Communist invasion of the Chinese Nationalist-held island would have to run over the 7th Fleet.

The President served that calm but measured reminder to the Reds in answer to a question at his news conference. Premier Chou En-lai said only last Friday that Communist China, quarters of Chiang Kai-shek's Nationalists, and warned the United States against interfering.

A reporter asked the President what would happen if the Reds did move in force against Formosa. Eisenhower said orders to the 7th Fleet to defend the island are still in effect.

"That has been our policy and it should continue to be," Smith commented.

Asked if his group had any information on whether the Communists are serious in threatening to take Formosa, Smith replied: "I think they're bluffing, but of course you never know when you're dealing with Communists."

On the use of other forces, Smith commented: "We might have to use some air, but we have plenty of that on Okinawa."

### Anaconda Copper Strike Called

BUTTE, Mont., (AP) — The Independent International Union of Mine, Mill and Smelter Workers have called a strike for Monday morning against the Anaconda Copper Mining Co.

Negotiations broke off Aug. 16. The union is asking a 23-cent hourly wage increase plus fringe benefits.
