

4-H, FFA GRAND CHAMPIONS SOLD

cents; total sales of steers, \$37,885.21. Average per pound was only two cents lower than last year's average of 36 cents per pound, and bidding on the Bonanza champion beef was only two cents per pound under bidding on Chester Schooler's 1953 champ.

Highest price paid in the sale was Dorothy Lowell's \$4.50 per pound for the champion lamb; next highest price was paid Martha Tubach for her reserve grand champion lamb — \$2.50 by Jerry Rajnus.

High bidding continued through the first and second place winners in the lamb division, sold by Gene Farmer, first, \$1.40 per pound by Charlie Read, Saddlery; Carol Reiling, first, \$1.50 by Sam Coon; Franklin Miller, second, \$1.35 by Loren Palmerton, and Eileen Fitzgerald, second, \$1.50 by City Ice and Storage Company.

The grand champion hog, sold by Carol Alberts, brought \$1.70 per pound from Crater Lake Machinery. Victor Ivie's reserve grand champion brought \$1.40 from Dugan and Mast. The grand champion FFA hog, shown by Ray Johnson, sold for 95 cents per pound to Sears, Roebuck and Company.

Prices on steers, outside of top winners, was relatively even. The 4-H grand champion's high price of 93 cents per pound was offered by 65 cents for Doug Fisk's reserve grand champion 4-H steer; 52 cents for the champion 4-H steer shown by Rod Wright and 48 cents for Jim Johnson's grand champion FFA steer.

Maximum weights on animals were 225 pounds for hogs, 100 pounds for lambs and 1,000 pounds for steers. Buyers paid only on the maximum although several of the entries exceeded the top pay poundage.

A complete record of the sale, which climaxed the third day of the show that opened Sunday, follows on page 8. The Klamath Falls Rotary Club served some 1800 guests at a free barbecue in the grandstand prior to the sale.

Exhibitors were in line early for the barbecue and then passed in a grand parade before a packed grandstand of special guests. Announcement of special awards and introduction of leaders and outstanding club members was made by Bud Chandler, manager of KFLW.

Katherine Ahern, Merrill, was crowned flower garden queen; Steven Southwell, Henley, was crowned vegetable garden king. Award of the Rotary Club sweepstakes trophy was made to the Foe Valley Shepherds for the second consecutive year. The club is led by Mr. and Mrs. Paul Hatchett.
