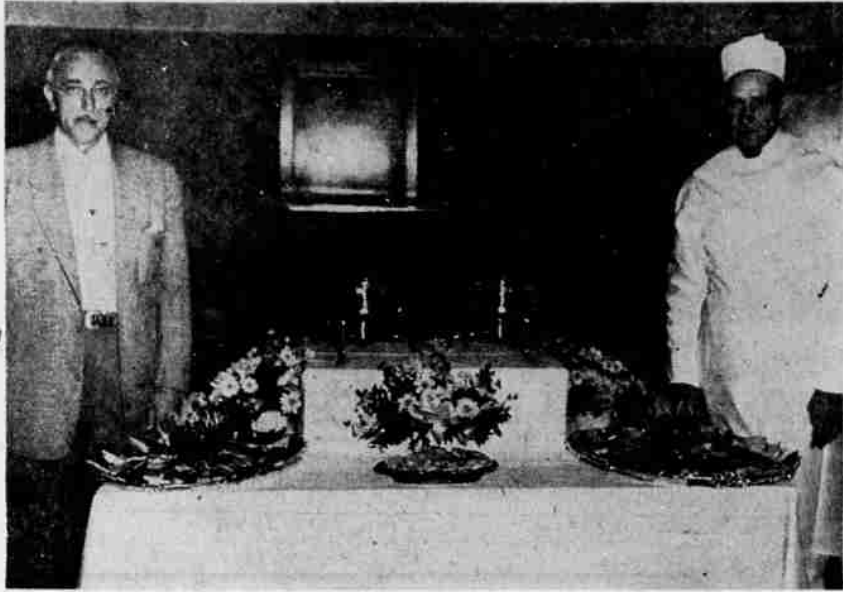

Simulated Leather

Since the leather look is a growing fashion, simulated leathers will be used to a greater degree. They usually cost less than genuine leather.

But, says the National Institute of Drycleaning, simulated leather garments cannot be drycleaned.

If they are not lined, they can usually be wetcleaned satisfactorily the institute states, but if they have rayon linings, wool quilted linings or trim, it is impossible to predict

the shrinkage of the lining fabric and trim.

Dresses made of drycleanable fabrics and trimmed with simulated leather cannot be drycleaned because the simulated leather becomes stiff and boardy. There is no way known to soften it after drycleaning, the institute adds.

COOL SALADS

To insure cold cocktails or salads, place salad plates or cocktail glasses in the refrigerator for a few minutes before placing on the table. Perfect insurance for crisp, tantalizing salads.

SANDWICH HINTS

When preparing sandwiches for the freezer, especially those with a soft filling, be sure to butter them well. For added flavor, try adding a bit of chopped parsley and a squeeze of lemon juice to the butter.

HOTELS

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New Influences Are Changing Silhouettes

The Chateau influence from Paris will make its strongest impact in the holiday collections now being prepared by suit makers, according to Womens Wear Daily.

While the fitted and flared silhouette may not seem startlingly new, designers and makers feel that this feminine silhouette will continue to have big appeal. There is newness, however, in the translation of the fitted and full in rich, elegant fabrics, and in the disposition of fullness, which has been transplanted from all-around to side or back. The front portion of the skirt is slim, or at most "easy."

Wide, face framing necklines, satin bows and rhinestone buckles project the dressier, romantic look further.

CASUAL DRESS

The casual dress is making a big comeback in sportswear, especially in the better market, WWD reports. The dresses are new looking in elegant fabrics, sometimes in brilliant jewel tones.

Beautifully cut, often in shirt-waist styling, bloused top with small pleats or tucks at the waistline and drop down in back for the long waistline silhouette.

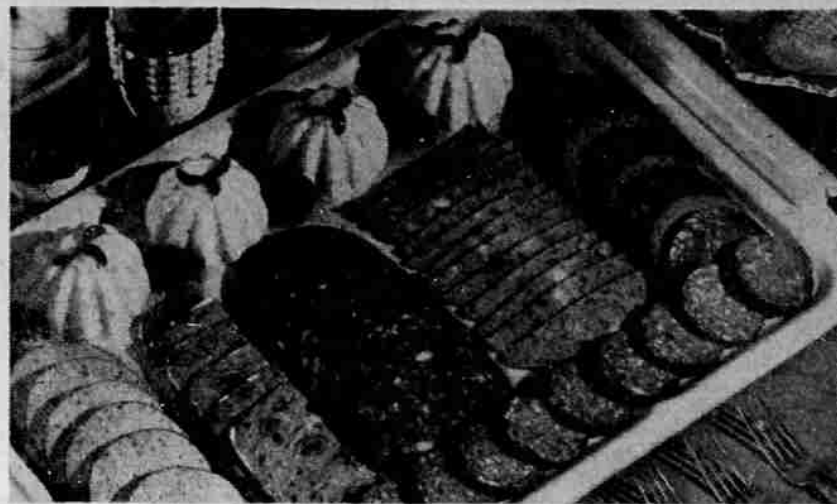
The casual dress has been taking a back seat to separates for the last few seasons but now is coming back with a new body line as a fashion to watch.

DIOR SILHOUETTE

The Dior silhouette, emphasizing long torso line, will result in some new-looking sweaters and knit dresses for resort clothes that develop the boxy, hip-length cut.

This is in direct opposition to current trends in which sweaters have been getting shorter and shorter. However, the new hip-length straight sweaters will be feminine and neat (anything but sloppy) and often coordinated with skirts and blouses for the important costume look. Seen are middie sweaters with linen collar and cuffs to match box-pleated linen skirt.

Knit dresses for resort will take advantage of the eased lines introduced by Paris. This is a boost to the industry, some sources point out, since casually fitted lines and looser knit dress tops are more flattering to most customers.



ENTERTAINING a couple or a crowd, nothing is much easier for the summer hostess than a platter of cold cuts. In this attractive arrangement, slices of summer sausage, bologna, relish loaf, liver sauce, spiced ham, pepperoni and salami are served with individual pineapple lime molds. For the molds, dissolve 2 packages lime flavored gelatin in 2 cups hot water. Chill until partially set. Then stir in 1 pint sour cream and 1 No. 2 can undrained crushed pineapple. Makes 8 servings.

Skirts for School

Wool skirts, especially those that can be washed without shrinking, are prominent in fall wardrobes for the back-to-school girls.

New this year is the Bermuda length skirt, launched by Stanley Wilkins, sportswear designer. He styles it of Sanforian wool in both flannel and tweed versions. It's a sure fire hit with college and career girls who ensemble it with tailored blouse and new knee length socks.

Boxer-type skirts (and semi-boxers) are headline news also. They effect a slim silhouette and yet the elastic belt with gathered fullness provides an adjustable easy fitting waistline.

Trouser detail styles either slim skirts and even simulate the knife-like press of trousers with narrow seam detail running the length of the skirt.

Gored skirts range from 4 to 16 gore editions. There are interesting "umbrella" types and some are sun-rayed tucked for detail. Flares are good but always it is the controlled flare rather than the swirl effect.

Skirts with spaced fullness com-

prise another whole new style group. Novel variations in box pleating, cartridge pleats and accordion pleats are among the most interesting. Plaid wools are most effective in these skirts, with the plaid pattern often emphasizing the pleat in detail.

An innovation in popular priced wool skirts is the increased use of skirt linings. More and more manufacturers are adding this extra feature to eliminate the "sat-out" look.

SHOWER SUGGESTION

An attractive table centerpiece for your next wedding or baby shower can be a large bowl, tray or basket into which is placed all the shower gifts. Choose a container that can be an extra gift in which the guest of honor can carry home all the presents received. For a bride, for instance, a small wicker clothes basket, with perky bows perched on each handle, makes a useful and attractive gift.

KABOBS
Pitted cooked prunes wrapped in bacon go well with chunks of marinated lamb strung together on skewers. Broil so that prunes and meat do not touch the coals.

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
