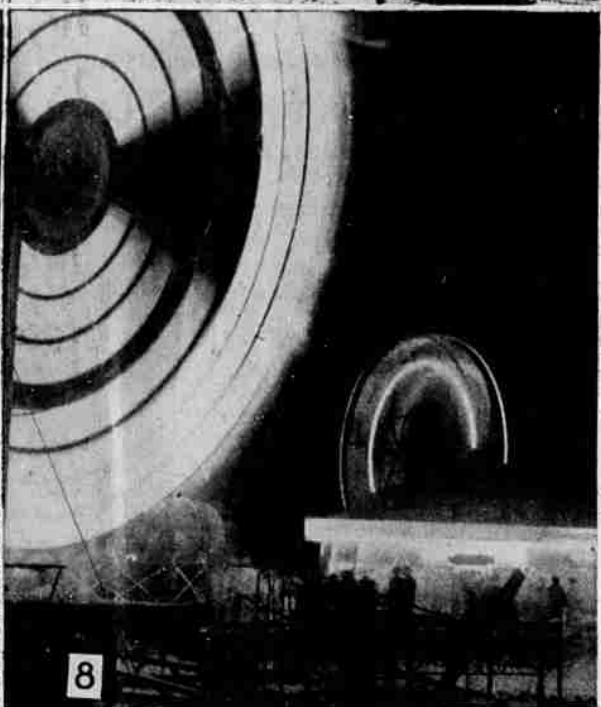


Picture News Of Annual Lakeview Roundup
