## Nationalists Shell Amoy

TAIPEH, Formosa (E)—Chinese Nationalist artillery on Quemoy and Communist big guns on the nearby mainland fired upwards of 2,000 shells last night in a savage hour-long duel, an army spokesman said today.

He described the exchange as the heaviest since the fighting broke out around Quemoy Sept. 3.

Nationalist planes and warships took over at dawn today, bombarding Amoy and other Red bases within artillery range of Quemoy for the 21st straight day, the Defense Ministry announced.

Lt. Gen. Chang Ti-ling, army spokesman, said the air force destroyed six Communist gunboats Wednesday.

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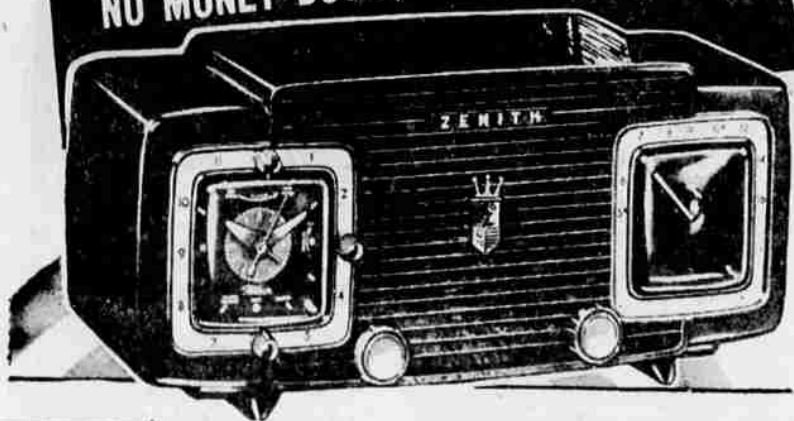
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
