Klamath Falls Creamery Provides Venison Care

Klamath Basin deer hunters are fortunate in having the facilities of the meat department of the Klamath Falls Creamery available when they bring in their deer.

Starting in 1931, with the advent of the first cold storage lockers in Oregon, the Klamath Falls Creamery has handled up to 2,000 deer in a single season. The department has been readied for the opening of the deer season on October 2.

Deer must be handled in a far different way than beef, according to Cy Baker, manager of the creamery meat operation. Hunters are cautioned by the local butchers to handle their deer properly when first killed. Proper cleaning and cooling is of utmost importance to the ultimate quality of the meat.

Deer should be thoroughly cooled out and kept cool. In past years, up to half of the deer received at the creamery have not been properly cared for. During the past few years this percentage has declined, but still many are brought in that have started to spoil, Baker stated. It is a fallacy to believe that the smaller the opening made to clean the deer the better, particularly on a hot day. Baker says just the opposite is true, as the animal heat leaves the animal more slowly during hot weather and it is essential to open the deer as much as possible.

The deer carcasses are received on Klamath Avenue across the street from the main creamery building. Here a large cooler is available and other facilities that enable operators to handle the highly perishable game very quickly.

All deer received are skinned at once and then put in a cold room to set the meat and insure the highest possible quality.

The public is welcome at the Klamath Avenue receiving station, Baker added, at any time Saturday or Sunday evenings to see the local hunters' results. He assures the visitors that they will not have to beg for the facts, as most successful hunters are always willing to give all the details and a regular carnival spirit prevails the first two or three evenings of the season.

The local creamery's deer cutting operation recently received national recognition in a large dairy journal as being unique among all creamery side lines.
