Democrats also have scheduled a number of out-of-state speakers to urge election of Richard L. Neuberger, Gordon's opponent, and other Democrats.

The driver, Kenneth Lawrence Hill, 43, Oregon City, suffered only minor injuries. He was booked in the Clackamas County jail on a negligent homicide charge. Bail was set at \$2,500.
