Big Indoor Sport

At least one billion two hundred million hours are devoted annually to card playing in the United States.

That's the claim made by the Association of American Playing Card Manufacturers. The association says that each year, since World War II, at least 60 million packs of playing cards have been sold in this country. It is estimated that an average of four people use a deck and the life of the average deck is conservatively put at five hours of solid play.

Thus 60 million packs times four players per pack times five consecutive hours of play comes out to one billion two hundred million hours which the association believes is a greater number of hours than are given to any other sport or game.

The card manufacturers point out further that these figures are all minimum, since more than 60 million packs are sold annually, decks are frequently used for much more than five hours of play, and games like poker, Hearts and some forms of Rummy and Michigan are usually played by five or more people at a time.

CLOSET-CLEANING TIME

When it's time to switch over from warm weather clothes to fall and winter clothes, it's a good time to clean closets thoroughly. Reserve your shelves and cabinets for only those items which are used frequently. Remove all the contents of the closets and wash all interior walls, shelves, floor and rods with hot soapsuds and rinses. This not only removes loose soil, but also reduces the subsequent damage from moths. Be sure to let the closets air and dry well before stocking them again with clean clothes. Wash all the hangers occasionally, too.

For the dessert pictures, make angel food cake according to the directions on the package of mix. Cool; slice in serving pieces.

Just before serving, place spoonfuls of ice cream on each slice of cake. Then pour maple-blended syrup over the ice cream.
