Nobel Peace Prize Out

OSLO, Norway (AP) — The Norwegian Nobel Prize committee announced Friday no Nobel Peace Prize will be awarded this year. Oddly enough, the announcement came as the world was free of major war for the first time in many years.

Gen. George C. Marshall of the United States won the prize last year. At the same time, Dr. Albert Schweitzer was given the peace award for 1952, when it was omitted in similar fashion, without explanation.

The prize, one of several—for peace, for literature, for medicine, for chemistry, for physics—established under the will of Swedish dynamite inventor Alfred Nobel, is worth in the neighborhood of \$35,000 in cash and brings high honor to its winner.

WORCESTER, Mass. (AP) — William Martin, 21, spent six days in jail here last summer through mistaken identity.

He is back in jail today and police say there is no question about his identity this time.
