



Russian Air Power Eyed

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — Secretary of the Navy Charles S. Thomas said Wednesday Russia has atom bomb carrying airplanes that fly faster than the speed of sound.

His statement apparently was the first by a qualified American official to attribute such speed to Russian bombers.

The air force has said only that Russian jet bombers, unveiled last spring, have given the Soviets the ability to wage inter-continental air warfare with fast planes comparable to the B47 all-jet bomber and the even larger and more powerful B52.

Thomas gave no elaboration in the prepared text of a speech prepared for the Greater Philadelphia-Delaware-South Jersey Council.

After saying what other American officials have reported many times—that the Soviets have a 20,000-plane air force which includes many latest type jets—the Navy secretary said the Russians have "atomic weapons and aircraft faster than the speed of sound with which to deliver them." (At sea level, sound travels at about 760 miles an hour.)

Thomas declared that the Russian navy, now second in size among world fleets, is engaged in a "fast but silent effort" to challenge U. S. naval supremacy. Asserting that the Russians have a submarine force of a size never before equaled in history, Thomas said the whole purpose of Soviet emphasis upon sea power, since World War II has been "nullify our command and use of the seas."

Summer Camp Program Told

Many Oregon youngsters should now have a better understanding of the principle of "wise use of Oregon's natural resources." The Oregon Game Commission's summer youth camp program in conservation reached the ears of over 10,000 young campers during the past summer months. Of the 13,034 youngsters registered at the various camps visited by game commission personnel, 10,910 attended the wildlife sessions.

A total of 129 sessions was held in 53 separate camps, which included Y M C A, denominational, Camp Fire girls, Girl Scout, Boy Scout, and 4-H camps. Aside from participation in the regular camp activities, commission representatives spent over 650 hours with youngsters on wildlife discussions and hikes.

Emphasis was placed on the sound management of Oregon's wildlife, but wise use of soils, water, plant life, and wildlife was stressed to enable youngsters to better understand their responsibilities in the stewardship of these valuable resources.

From its inception in 1950 by Austin Hamer, the program has mushroomed from a one man

crew and 25 sessions to a five man crew and 129 sessions in 1954. If the increase is any indication, it seems that interest in conservation is on the upswing.
