East Favored By Weather

Summer-like weather appeared the outlook again Thursday for broad areas in the eastern third of the nation while it was on the chilly side over much of the West.

Temperatures were far above seasons levels Wednesday and during the night over the Southern and Central states and along most of the Atlantic Coast. New record readings for the date were reported in several Eastern and Southern cities Wednesday. It was a mild 69 in Chicago early Thursday, nearly 25 degrees above normal for the date.

Temperatures were in the 90s and upper 80s over the Eastern and Southern warm belts Wednesday. The 85 in New York broke a 75 year record for Oct. 13. It was 89 in Washington and 86 in Boston and a hot 98 in Wichita Falls, Tex.

Showers and thundershowers occurred during the night from the Great Lakes southwestward to Kansas and Colorado. Snow was reported at Denver, where it was

near freezing. Heaviest rainfall was from Kansas northeastward into Wisconsin, with nearly two inches in some cities.

It was cool over the northern and Central Rockies, the Great Basin and most of the Pacific Northwest with readings in the 30s over most of the area. Skies were clear over the Southern Rockies and the Southwest.

Man Drowns In Smith River

REEDSPORT (AP) — An attempt to swim across the Smith River to recover a sunken skiff cost the life of Clarence Thompson, about 50, of Bandon on Tuesday.

With Carl Henderson he set out across the river, 20 miles upstream from Gardiner. Henderson made it, but Thompson went under. The body was recovered.
