

Clues Left By Man's Killer

MIDDLESBORO, Ky. (AP) — The identity of a bullet-riddled body found in a lover's lane rested today on two clues apparently overlooked by the killer.

One was an affectionate note; the other a laundry mark in the slain man's shirt and trousers. They were stamped "Fox."

The victim, in his late 20's or early 30's, had been shot six times—once in the head, three times in the chest, and twice in the back.

Police said the man had been dead about 12 hours before two men searching for firewood stumbled across the body yesterday.

The note crammed into a watch pocket started out "Hi, Honey, love you," and was signed Harriet and Ronnie Jr. Since the contents indicated the note was from the man's wife, police theorized his name also may have been Ronnie.

Robbery apparently was the motive but Middlesboro Police Capt. Cecil Grubbs said the man's wallet and other possessions may have been removed to throw them off the trail.

Chrysler Unveils New Auto Line

Chrysler Corporation rolled out for the inspection of the press on October 11 its five lines of spectacularly designed passenger cars for 1955 and expressed its confidence the automobiles will help it recapture more than 20 per cent of next year's market.

President L. L. Colbert said the new models developed at a cost of more than \$250,000,000 will prove to be "one of the best investments Chrysler has ever made."

By the middle of November Chrysler Corporation will have close to 100,000 people at work throughout the United States. This is an increase of 50,000 over the average of the last six months.

Discussing the corporation's original goal of 20 per cent of the market, Colbert said:

"Today that goal is beginning to look very modest. First we are shooting for 20 per cent and when we hit that target we'll raise our sights still higher."

He said Chrysler was backing up its confidence in its new cars with the most intensive advertising campaign in history and that newspapers will be the front line of the campaign.

In the first four months, he said Chrysler expenditures for newspaper advertising alone will be 10 per cent above that for the comparable period this year.

Perhaps never before in the history of the automobile industry has any company charted such an ambitious one year comeback attempt or undertaken such a complete and diversified model changeover program.

Present plans call for the introduction of the new models simultaneously on November 17.
