HOLLYWOOD (AP)—Today we're burying one of Hollywood's richest characters, Stanley Rose, who died broke. Stanley was never rich in terms of material wealth. But his life was rich in legend and few men had more friends. I counted myself lucky to be one of them. As far as I can judge, he had only one enemy and that was John Barleycorn. His death came last Sunday, because of a throat hemorrhage, at 55. Rose was a fey character who could be counted on to do the unpredictable. He proved that in World War I. Alabama Killer May Be Named

PHENIX CITY, Ala. (AP)—The gunman whose bullets cut short the crime-fighting career of A. L. Patterson four months ago is still a hunted killer, but investigators may have the goods on him. Despite the cautious secrecy of Acting Atty. Gen. Bernard Sykes, who is directing the murder inquiry, homicide detectives say privately they think they know the assassin's name.

"We feel sure we have a good sound case against the man who did it," said one homicide detective, "but there are a few loose ends to be tied up." And, he added, "there may be others involved, and we want to get them too."

Other sources close to the investigation corroborated the story, but none of the officers would divulge details. Sykes commented merely that "we think we're making progress." Neither would he say when the case will be presented to the emergency grand jury which was empaneled to investigate the Patterson slaying and to prosecute racketeers caught in Phenix City's wholesale vice cleanup. The elder Patterson had been nominated for attorney general on a pledge to rid Phenix City of organized crime. His law partner son won the nomination without opposition after his father was killed. Hundreds of witnesses have been questioned, but no one has been charged with the killing.

curtains around his bed in the hospital because he wasn't expected to live. But his Texas spirit wouldn't give up that easily. He was born in Matador, Tex., and that was ironic. One of his last deals as a book agent was selling the life story of Pat McCormick, the lady bullfighter. After the war, he turned up in Wichita Falls, which was enjoying a boom. When his luck ran out, he flipped a coin to determine whether he would go to Chicago or Hollywood, Chicago lost. He set up the Salyr Book Shop on Hollywood Boulevard, and it was a landmark for movie stars, novelists, con men and producers for 17 years. One of the young kids who haunted the place was Budd Schulberg. Stanley got ample mention in the lad's first novel, "What Makes Sammy Run." Stanley knew them all—Chaplin, Pickford, Fairbanks, Griffith, Barrymore. He used to pal around with a onetime boiler-maker named Mack Sennett, among others. He hired a young man from Fresno to sweep out the store. His name: William Saroyan. Stanley used to take a load of books and peddle them down the halls of the studio offices. Saroyan pushed the cart for him. The lack of a business sense finally did Stanley in. Out-of-work actors and writers spent hours in his shop reading books they never bought. Whatever profits came in promptly vanished in permanent loans to hangers-on. He sold out the shop and left Hollywood to raise tomatoes in the Imperial Valley with a man who is remembered only as "Moonface." But they soon found themselves out of the farming business and Stanley returned to Hollywood as a writer's agent. A bookie staked him to an office. One of Stanley's first big deals was establishing his former employe, Saroyan, as a big-name author. He sold Louis B. Mayer on the idea of having Saroyan take full charge in making a movie out of "The Human Comedy." MGM gave them a check for \$60,000. Saroyan and Rose revealed for three days, carrying the check around with them. No one would cash it for them. Stanley encouraged many a hopeful author who wanted to break into print. In his last months, he was in and out of the veterans' hospital and various Hollywood hotels. He has left little to his wife Maud and their son Bruce. But he brightened the lives of hundreds of people in and around Hollywood and he contributed more than one man's share to the literary product of America.
