Cheese Stars in Snacks

Cheese and fruits team up for snacks, desserts and cheese trays. Interesting cheese picks are made by alternating Tokay grapes and balls of cream and Blue cheese mixed with ground walnuts on wooden picks. Or, make balls of minced ham and cheese, moistened with mayonnaise.

Make cheese hors d'oeuvres by spreading thin cheese slices with mustard and deviled ham; roll and fasten with picks. Press pieces of Blue cheese between halves of walnuts or pecans.

CHEESE CLAM DUNK
Blend two 3-ounce packages of cream cheese with 1 cup minced clams, 1/2 tablespoon clam liquid, 1/2 teaspoon salt, dash of pepper and horseradish. Use for dunk or for spread. Keep cold. Makes 1 1/2 cups. For variation, add 1/2 package Blue cheese and 1/2 cup cream whipped.

CHEESE SANDWICHES
Try these fillings for cold sandwiches, suggests the Oregon Dairy Council:

Mix creamed cheese with chopped dates and nuts and spread on buttered brown bread.
Or, spread minced onion between thin slices of Swiss cheese and ham and use with rye bread.

For hot sandwiches, try shredded American cheese spread on thin onion slices on buttered bread; broil and serve.

Or, try thin slices of cheese and ham between thin slices of buttered bread; pan-fry at low heat in lots of butter.

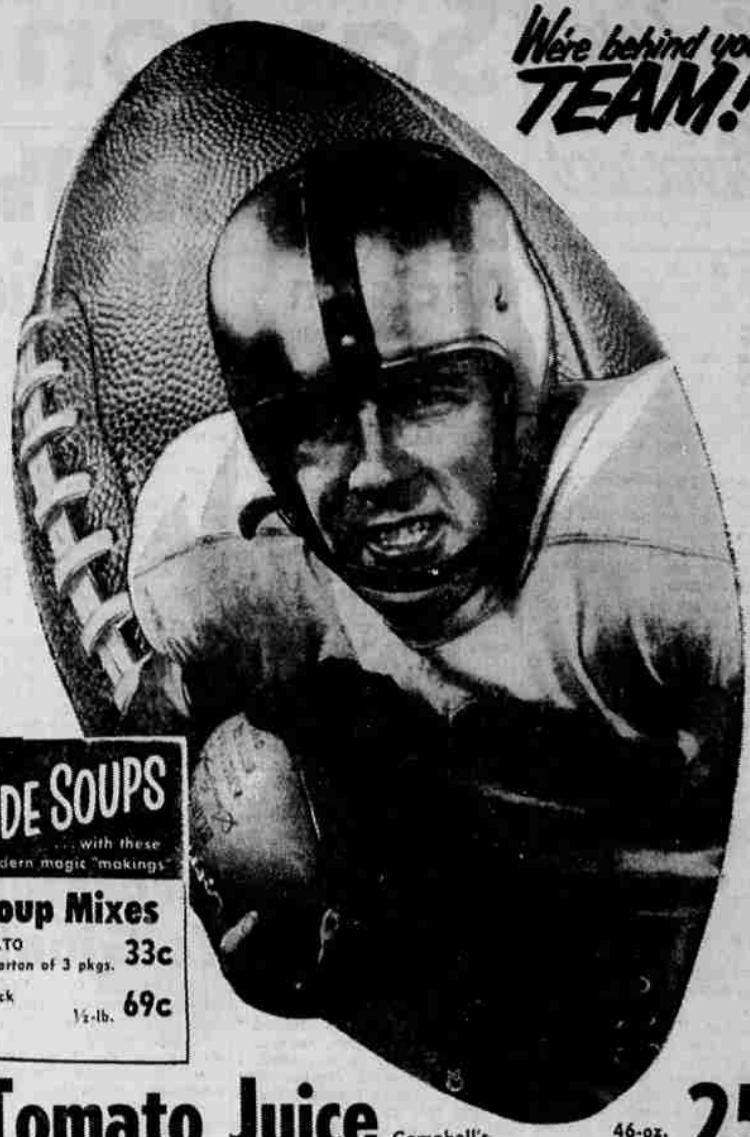
