## State School Board Asks More Funds

PORTLAND (AP) — The State Board of Higher Education, faced with an unexpectedly high enrollment at state colleges, decided Monday to ask the State Finance Department for an additional \$50,000 for the 1955-57 biennium.

The money will be used to hire 103 additional teachers.

An increase of 3 per cent was expected this fall. However, enrollments were up 14.5 per cent. Further increases of 8.4 per cent in 1955 and 8.6 per cent in 1956 are expected.

The board heard a report that at Portland State—where the increase in enrollment was greatest—there will be 26.6 students for each instructor in the 1955-57 period. The ratio for the other colleges now is 13.6 to 18.1 students per instructor.

People say, "If Portland State can do this, why can't you?" Portland State's students come to us. We are just as interested in their doing a good job at Portland State as we are that we do a good job at Oregon State College. I say let's help Portland State."

Dr. O. Meredith Wilson, president of the University of Oregon, said colleges throughout the nation were facing a teacher shortage, and maybe that is a good thing. But still, television is going to have to be used to spread instruction thinner," he said.

## Women Voters League Offer Advice On Coming Election

The following list of do's and don'ts regarding the coming election have been compiled by the Klamath Falls chapter of the League of Women Voters, and are printed here as a public service.

**VOTING PROCEDURE**

Polls in the state of Oregon are opened at 8 a.m. and closed at 8 p.m. P.M.T. November 2.

Go to the polling place in your voting precinct. You will find the number of your precinct on your registration card. Addresses of polling places for each precinct will be published in the Herald & News. Clip this for further reference.

Give your name to the election clerk. The clerk will hand you the ballot, which you take to the voting compartment or booth. Read the ballot carefully. Mark a cross (X) between the number and the name of the candidate for whom you wish to vote. In the initiative and referendum questions, mark a cross (X) between the number and the answer, "Yes" or "No."

Do not erase. If you make a mistake, ask for another ballot. Be careful not to vote for more candidates than the number indicated at the top of each category. You may, if you wish, vote for fewer candidates than indicated, but if you vote for more, your ballot is not counted in this category.

Check your ballot to see if you have voted as you intended. Now fold the ballot with the stub protruding so it can be torn off by the election chairman. Give your ballot and name to the clerk at the ballot box, and she will check your ballot number and deposit your ballot in the box.

Remember that a "no" vote is just as much a decision as a "yes" vote and used indiscriminately may be a determining factor in defeating a worthy measure which if passed would be in the public interest. The slogan often heard at election time "If in doubt vote 'no'" is not sound advice. Perhaps it would be better not to vote on a measure if you are not informed on it.
