



BUTTERSCOTCH TARTS

2 cups cold milk
1 package butterscotch instant pudding
One - third cup dates, chopped
1/2 cup pecans, chopped
6 baked, 4-inch tart shells
One - third cup whipping cream

Pour milk into mixing bowl. Add pudding mix and beat with egg beater 1 minute, or until well mixed. Quickly stir in dates and nuts. Pour at once into tart shells. Let stand 15 minutes before serving. Whip cream, sweetening to taste. Top each tart with whipped cream and garnish with a nut half if desired. Makes six tarts.

QUICK PUMPKIN TARTS
1/2 cup light cream
1/2 cup milk
1 package vanilla - flavored instant pudding mix
1 1/4 cups canned pumpkin
2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
1/4 teaspoon salt
5 baked tart shells

Sweetened whipped cream
Pour cream and milk into mixing bowl. Add pudding mix, pumpkin, spice and salt and beat with egg beater for one minute, or until well mixed. Pour immediately into baked tart shells. Let stand 15 minutes. Garnish with sweetened whipped cream. Makes five tarts.

QUICK PUMPKIN PUDDING
Use recipe for Quick Pumpkin Tarts filling. Pour at once into small custard cups or individual serving dishes. Sprinkle with fine graham cracker crumbs. Let stand five minutes to set.

QUICK DESSERTS make a winner of any hostess. At score-totaling time you can slip into the kitchen and prepare these richly smooth tarts, using butterscotch instant pudding and have them finished by the time the coffee has perked. Trick and Treat

Pizza continues to increase in popularity. You can make it at home in endless variety.

There are a few points to remember—roll the dough quite thin and it must be a yeast-dough base. Top the circle of dough with a brushing of olive oil, then add the tomato mixture and top with whatever you like in addition to cheese.

Here's an easy way to make the tomato mixture. Chop a medium size onion and a couple of cloves of garlic and saute gently in a couple of tablespoons of olive oil. Add a 6-ounce can of tomato

sauce, dash of salt and a couple of pinches of oregano and let simmer a few minutes.

Since Mozzarella cheese is unobtainable here, grated Romano may be used, or you can use shredded processed Swiss slices. Top with canned grated parmesan.

Pieces of Norway Kippers are good as a topping in addition to the cheese, or crumbled bacon or diced ham.

Appian Way Pizza dough will make twice as many pizzas as the recipe on the package indicates. Pillsbury hot roll mix makes a good base, too. Always remember to brush the pizza with olive oil before putting on the topping. Bake quickly in a hot oven until the cheese is melted.

10-Minute Apple Cookies

Having a Halloween party? Or getting ready for Trick or Treat callers who are sure to be ringing your doorbell on All Witches Eve?

Then, since apples are associated with Halloween, the number one item on your shopping list is probably a big bag of apples. If you don't want to give away the apples whole, try 10-Minute Apple Cookies. These cookies keep well and may also find their way into lunch boxes and the cookie jar for mid-afternoon snacks.

APPLE COOKIES

1/2 cup shortening
1 cup brown sugar
2 eggs
1/2 cup quick cooking oatmeal
1 cup raisins
1 1/2 cups chopped raw apple
1 teaspoon grated lemon peel
2 cups flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon soda
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1 cup chopped walnuts, optional

Cream shortening with sugar. Add eggs and blend well. Stir in oatmeal, raisins, chopped apples and lemon peel. Sift flour, measure and sift again with salt, baking powder, soda and cinnamon. Stir into creamy mixture. Add walnuts if desired. Drop by the teaspoonful onto a greased cookie sheet. Bake in a moderately hot oven (375 degrees) for 10 minutes or until lightly browned. Makes about 3 dozen small cookies.
