

U.N. Debates Eisenhower's Atoms-For-Peace Program

UNITED NATIONS, N. Y. (AP) — France kept the debate on President Eisenhower's atoms-for-peace program rolling in the U. N. Assembly today as delegates studied a new seven-power resolution designed to make the program effective.

The resolution was put into the Assembly proper over the week-end by the United States and six other countries already negotiating to set up an international atomic energy agency. They are Britain, Canada, Belgium, France, Australia and South Africa.

There was no indication when the Soviet Union would reply to

invitations to join the agency, extended by President Eisenhower, Secretary of State Dulles and U.N. Delegate Henry Cabot Lodge Jr.

Delegates expect Andrei Vishinsky, Soviet deputy foreign minister, to demand Red China's inclusion in the list of countries invited to send scientists to an international center on the peaceful use of atomic energy. The resolution calls for the U. N. to summon the scientific congress before August 1955.

The resolution provides that delegates to the congress would come from members of the U. N. and the specialized agencies, the latter including some from Communist countries not members of the U. N. that it might open a door to Red China, which in 1951 was voted membership in the Universal Postal Union, the only specialized agency to which the Chinese Reds have gained admission.

When reporters pointed this out to the U. S. delegation Saturday night, the resolution was withdrawn hastily for a check but later was reinstated. A U. S. spokesman said there was no clear record the Red Chinese were still members of the postal union, and that anyway the United States would never let them be invited to the congress.

In Bern, Switzerland, officials of the postal union said today that the Chinese Nationalist government is the recognized representative of China in the agency. These sources said Red China's admission to the union was for its 1951 meeting only.

The other section of the U. S. atomic resolution would give the U. N. Assembly's endorsement to the international atomic energy agency the United States wants to set up, with or without the Russians. It also would link it with the U. N. in a status similar to that of the specialized agencies.

American Meat Use Predicted

Next year, for the third year in a row, people in this country will continue to eat meat at the rate of 153 to 154 pounds per person. More of that meat will be beef and less of it pork.

Marketing specialists of the U. S. Department of Agriculture say beef production will stay large, and veal production will probably increase some. Lamb will continue a comparatively scarce meat but pork will be more plentiful next year than this.

The specialists say that in general prices of meat at retail will average about the same next year as this.

Collins Lands In Viet Nam

SAIGON, Viet Nam (AP) — Gen. J. Lawton Collins, President Eisenhower's special envoy to South Viet Nam, arrived today to lend a hand at trying to solve the acute political and economic crisis threatening the Indochinese country.

Coming in his personal plane from Tokyo, Collins said he had devoted considerable study to the situation in Viet Nam but came with "no preconceived notions or anything of that sort."

The former U. S. Army chief of staff added that he hoped to "render maximum help to the Vietnamese people in solving their problems."

Collins' findings and recommendations will form the basis of the future U. S. aid program for South Viet Nam. Eisenhower has available several hundred million dollars for such a program, but Collins must determine that his use in the fight against communism has a reasonable chance of success.

He also will fill in for U. S. Ambassador Donald R. Heath, who returns to the United States next Sunday for reassignment.

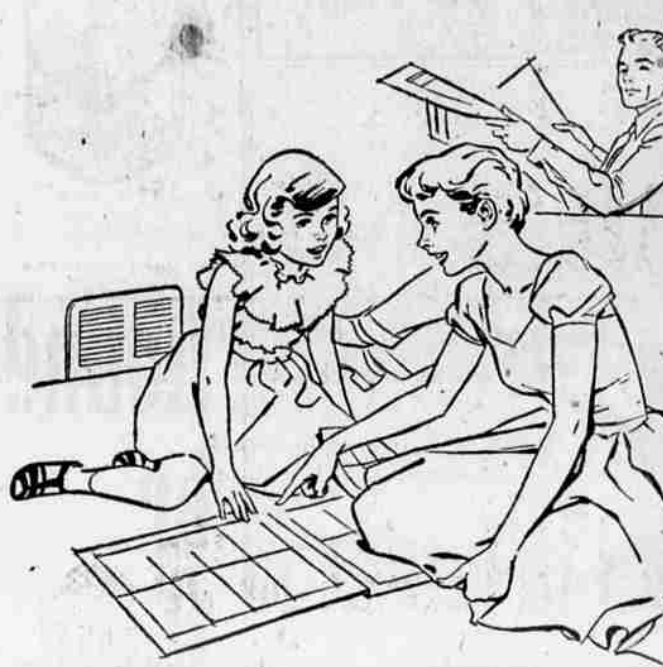
