Many an entree has been dressed up by the addition of stewed or canned tomatoes. Main dishes, such as these Meat Balls with Tomatoes, are hearty and filling. The meat balls are made with beef and pork, well seasoned with onions, crisp cereal, salt and pepper. Meat balls are browned. Tomatoes are added and the entire mixture cooked for 45 minutes. Delicious, warming and colorful, this entree is worth trying.

MEAT BALLS WITH TOMATOES

$\frac{3}{4}$ pound ground beef
 $\frac{3}{4}$ pound ground pork or sausage
1 egg, slightly beaten
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup finely chopped onions
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon salt
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon pepper
2 cups Rice Krispies
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups cooked tomatoes

Combine meats, egg, onions, seasonings and Rice Krispies; mix well. Shape into 12 balls. Fry meat balls in small amount of heated shortening or dripping, turning until well browned on all sides. Pour on tomatoes; cover. Continue cooking over low heat about 45 minutes or until meat balls are thoroughly cooked. Serve at once. Yield 6 servings, 2 medium meat balls each.
