



GOOD GROOMING does not end with a pat of powder, a dash of perfume and tresses which sparkle and shine. It is just as important to keep the tools of good grooming in shining condition as it is to keep yourself looking your loveliest.

GROOMING TOOLS SHOULD SPARKLE

How do you rate? Are your comb and brush fresh and clean? Are they kept that way? Do your mirrors reflect a dazzling you? Not only the bathroom mirror, which quickly becomes dimmed with frequent steamings, but your hand mirror, should be polished with regularity. How about your perfume bot-

ties and powder jars? Keeping all of these items lustrous and bright may sound like a never-ending task, but even a working gal has time for these chores with a box of baking soda to her rescue. Baking soda, which is pure mild bicarbonate of soda, has myriads of good grooming uses besides cleaning teeth and relaxing baths. Here's a quick rundown of how to keep those grooming aids as pert and fresh as their user.

Just make a solution of three tablespoons baking soda to a quart of water. Sponge glass, china and plastic utensils with this solution, then rinse and dry. Whisk stains from silver items by rubbing on a paste of baking soda and water, rinse with clear water and polish dry to a jeweler's luster.

Combs and brushes, too, respond to baking soda's care. Add three tablespoons of soda to the water in which you wash these items. Baking soda emulsified the greasy film which clings to comb and brush and leaving them wonderfully fresh and sweet-smelling.

STARCHING AND SPRINKLING

Did you know you can combine your starching and your sprinkling without having to immerse a garment into the starch? Just mix a cold water starch solution according to directions on the package and swish it around till the starch is completely dissolved. Next, pour the solution into a sprinkling bottle or squeeze-bulb (type of dispenser and sprinkle the clean, dry fabric until it's damp all over. Then fold and wrap it in a towel or in plastic for a couple of hours before ironing.
