MEN LIKE GLAMOUR

Cookies for Holidays

RAISIN DROP COOKIES
(Quick-Mix Method)
2 cups sifted enriched flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 cup brown sugar
1/2 cup new-type shortening
1 egg
1/4 cup milk
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 cup raisins
Sift together flour, baking powder and salt. Add brown sugar,

shortening, egg, milk and vanilla extract. Mix to blend ingredients. Then beat 300 strokes by hand or 2 minutes at medium speed on electric mixer. Add raisins and mix thoroughly. Drop by spoonfuls on ungreased baking sheet and bake in moderate oven (375 degrees) 10 to 15 minutes. Makes about 4 dozen 2-inch cookies.

SNOWBERRY COOKIES
(Quick Cherry Cookies)
2 cups sifted enriched flour
1/2 teaspoon soda
1 teaspoon salt
1 cup brown sugar
1/2 cup new-type shortening
1 egg
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
2 tablespoons milk
1/2 cup chopped nuts
1/2 cup chopped candied or maraschino cherries
1/2 cup coconut
Sift together flour, soda and salt into mixing bowl. Add sugar, shortening and egg. Mix vanilla extract with milk and add to flour mixture. Stir to combine ingredients, then beat 2 minutes (300 strokes). Stir in nuts, cherries and coconut. Drop by spoonfuls on greased baking sheet. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees) 10 to 15 minutes. Makes about 4 dozen 2-inch cookies.

SPITZ COOKIES
4 1/2 cups sifted enriched flour
1/2 teaspoon soda
1 teaspoon salt
2 cups shortening
1 1/2 cups sugar
3 eggs, beaten
Sift together flour, soda and salt. Cream together shortening and sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs. Add flour mixture, mixing well. Force dough through cookie press onto cookie sheets. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees) 15 minutes. Makes about 6 dozen 2-inch cookies.

1 cup diced cooked carrots
1/2 cup chopped green pepper
2 lbs. chopped onion

2 cups cream-style corn
1 cup milk
3 lbs. melted butter
1/2 teaspoon salt
Buttered cracker crumbs

Cook Mission Egg Noodles in boiling salted water until nearly tender, about 4 minutes, and drain. While noodles are cooking, combine tuna, carrots, green pepper, onion.
